5 2005 and are set forth in the Engineer's Report to be presented to this City Council for
6 consideration.

7 3. The City of Culver City hereby declares its intention to levy the annual
8 assessment on the eighteen (18) members of this assessment district for fiscal year
9 2007/2008.

10 4. The City Engineer is hereby ordered to prepare and file with the City
11 Clerk, for submission to the City Council, an Engineer's Report relating to said annual
12 assessment and levy in accordance with the provisions of Section 15.01.055 of the Culver
13 City Municipal Code.

14 5. Upon receipt of the City Engineer's report, and in accordance with the
15 provisions of Section 15.01.070 of the Culver City Municipal Code, the City Clerk is hereby
16 ordered to give notice of the time and place a public hearing will be held by the City Council
17 to consider objections and protests.
