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6. **LECTURE/LIMITED TIME PERFORMANCE**

Ratification of the administrative approval given by the City Manager and City Treasurer, pursuant to C.C.M.C. Section 11.01.515, to Marty Aghejian, Manager of ***BEST WIRELESS***, to conduct a two-day Valentine weekend promotion sale, outdoors, open to the public, with tents, a helium balloon display on the building, and free barbeque at the commercial location of 10960 Jefferson Blvd., on Saturday, February 9 and 10, 2008, from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., *provided that* all terms and conditions set forth by the Culver City Police Department, Planning Division, Engineering Division, and Fire Prevention Bureau, are met and adhered to at all times. A plot plan was submitted and approved by the Planning and Fire Divisions. Approximately 25-50 people are expected to attend each day. Previous permits have been issued.

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7. **LECTURE/LIMITED TIME PERFORMANCE**

Application by Alan Kummer, Owner of ***THE MATTRESS STORE***, to conduct a three-day Presidents' Day parking lot sale open to the public on Saturday, February 16, 2008, Sunday, February 17, 2008, and Monday, February 18, 2008 from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the commercial location of 5577 Sepulveda Blvd., *provided that* all terms and conditions set forth by the Culver City Police Department, Planning Division, and Fire Prevention Bureau, are met and adhered to at all times. A plot plan was submitted and approved by the Planning Division. Approximately 200 customers are expected to attend throughout the course of the sale. Previous permits have been issued.

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8. **LECTURE/LIMITED TIME PERFORMANCE**

Application by Andrew Weissman and the ***COMMITTEE TO ELECT ANDREW WEISSMAN***, to conduct a one-day campaign fundraiser at the commercial location of 4114 Sepulveda Blvd., on Saturday, March 1, 2008, from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m., *provided that* all terms and conditions set forth by the Culver City Police Department, Planning Division, and Fire Prevention Bureau, are met and adhered to at all times. The event is open to the public and will be catered by *Pacifico's*. Alcohol will be served. Approximately 200 people are expected to attend. This is the first application for a permit.

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9. **PERSONAL PROPERTY RENTAL**

Application by Thomas O. Tieche, Jr., owner of ***EAST PEAK RENTALS***, to conduct a business of renting personal property consisting of camera equipment to studio production companies from his home while working on movie/commercial productions, *provided that* the applicant is truthful and honest in his responses to the questions regarding criminal history on the Application for Permit – Police Department. The applicant has been informed of the hearing. This is the first application for a permit.
