First, all documents, communications, recordings, emails, attachments, text messages, videos, photos, data, reports, analyses, opinions, and other records (collectively, the "Information") related to the Jubilo Village project from 2019 until present.

Second, all Information arising from or related to the City's or the City Council's interaction with any employee, consultant, officer, or representative of the Community Corporation of Santa Monica (including all related entities) since the initial conception of the Jubilo Village project in 2019.

Third, all Information arising from or related to the City's or the City Council's interaction with any employee, consultant, officer, or representative of the Culver-Palms United Methodist Church (including all related entities) since the initial conception of the Jubilo Village project in 2019.

Fourth, all Information arising from or related to any City Councilor's communications with Disa Lindgren, whether expressly mentioning Jubilo Village or not, since 2019.

Please retain such information in a manner that makes it readily available when necessary and until the prospective legal claim is either withdrawn or dismissed. Note that I will be making a simultaneous public records request for this information through the Culver City portal.
