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WHEREAS, homelessness continues to be a pressing issue for the City of Culver City ("Culver City") and Los Angeles County ("County") as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the County of Los Angeles Homeless Initiative has identified 47 strategies to combat homelessness, with many of them providing cities access to County resources, such as mental health services, outreach workers, and supportive housing; and

WHEREAS, the County is available to provide technical assistance and linkage to community partners to support Culver City's efforts to implement strategies to combat homelessness; and

- Contributing funding toward the cost of rapid re-housing for homeless Culver City residents;
- Dedicating federal housing subsidies to permanent supportive housing for chronically homeless individuals;

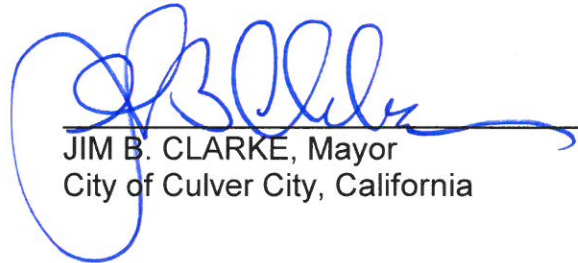
- Ensuring that law enforcement and other first responders effectively engage homeless families and individuals; and
- Using land use policies to maximize the availability of homeless and affordable housing.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES  
HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

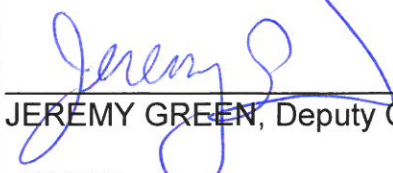
1. The City Council of Culver City hereby endorses and supports the County of Los Angeles Homeless Initiative strategies to combat homelessness.
