WHEREAS, on March 11, 2021, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) was signed into law by the President. Section 9901 of ARPA amended Title VI of the Social Security Act to add section 602, which established the Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund, and section 603, which established the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds. The Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Funds were established to provide support to local governments to respond to the impacts of COVID-19 on communities, residents, and businesses; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Treasury has adopted guidance regarding the use of ARPA funds. Section 602(c)(1) and 603(c)(2) provides that funds may be used:

- 1-

1 C. For the provision of government services to the extent there has
2 been a reduction in revenue due to the COVID-19 public health
3 emergency relative to revenues collected in the most recent full
4 fiscal year prior to the emergency;

5 D. To make necessary investment in water, sewer, or broadband
6 infrastructure; and

7 WHEREAS, Culver City revenues have faced economic impacts due to the
8 pandemic and, based on the City's preliminary estimates, the City has lost potential General
9 Fund Revenues of \$19.6M in calendar year 2020 and an estimated \$12M in 2021; and

10 WHEREAS, the City, in response to the pandemic, has had expenditures for
11 general services including public works (maintenance of buildings, infrastructure, roads,
12 etc.) public safety services, and non-reimbursed COVID-19 supplies/expenses, and any
13 future expenditures, consistent with the Department of Treasury's ARPA guidance.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
15 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, as follows:

16 The City Council confirms the estimated \$9,373,884 in Local Fiscal Recovery
17 Funds shall be allocated and managed in accordance with the Department of Treasury
18 Guidelines.

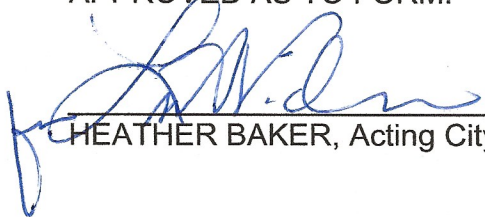
