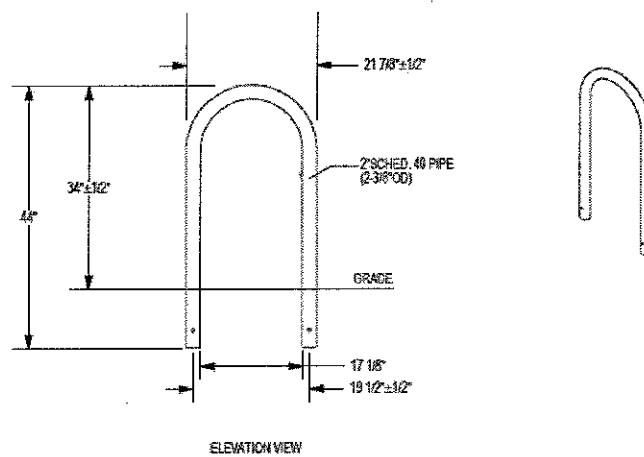

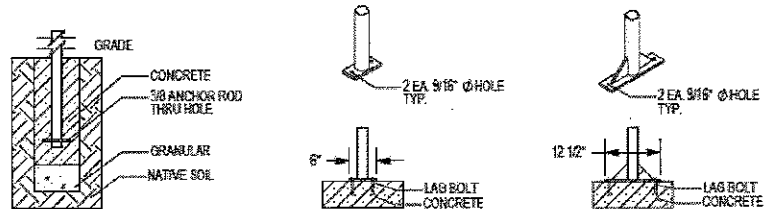

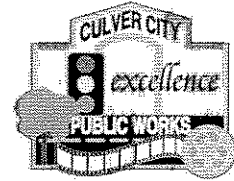

Bicycle Rack Installation Program

In an effort to become a more bike friendly city, the City of Culver City has initiated a bicycle rack installation program. This program allows businesses and residents to request bicycle racks on public rights-of-way (i.e. sidewalks) in and other public property.

To participate, simply review the location criteria, fill out the attached form with your requested location, and e-mail it to Christopher Evans at christopher.evans@culvercity.org.

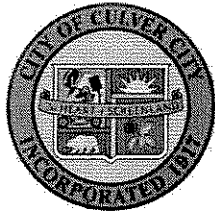
A City Representative will review the application and visit the site to determine whether it meets the City's criteria and is appropriate for a bicycle rack installation. If the location is deemed appropriate, the installation will occur pending availability. As a result of a recent State Bicycle Transportation Account grant that the City secured, there is no fee for the rack or installation at this time.

Rack Responsibility Racks will at all times be the property of the City of Culver City. The City assumes responsibility for the bike rack but NOT for any property parked at the rack.

Type of Rack The City of Culver City uses an inverted-U rack. The rack is approximately 36" tall and 24" in length. The rack is designed to park two bikes with two points of contact.

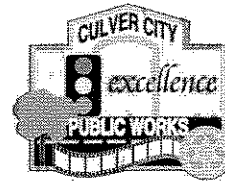
Location Criteria The City of Culver City will install bike racks on public right-of-way and other public property. Rack locations must generally meet the following guidelines (unless the Public Works Department approves a variation in siting criteria):

- Should be located in areas that are prominent and easily accessible to the main public entrance to a facility or other destination
- Must not conflict with normal pedestrian flow on sidewalks or with parked vehicles at curb. For this reason, sidewalks must be wide enough to accommodate pedestrian traffic along with bike parking (typically a minimum of 8 feet, but preferably at least 10 feet)
- Should be in secure locations that provide adequate lighting and good visibility
- Must not interfere with trees, posts, fire hydrants, bus shelters, or other similar items in the public right-of-way
- Cannot be installed on pavers, cobblestones, bricks, custom patterned concrete, metal gratings or placed over catch basins or utility boxes
- If parallel to curb, must be at least 2 feet away from curb; if perpendicular, must be at least 4 feet away from curb. Multiple racks must be at least 5 feet apart end-to-end
- Racks may be subject to additional specific guidelines not listed here
- Preference is given to racks that are in high demand areas such as near retail centers, transit stops, and public facilities
