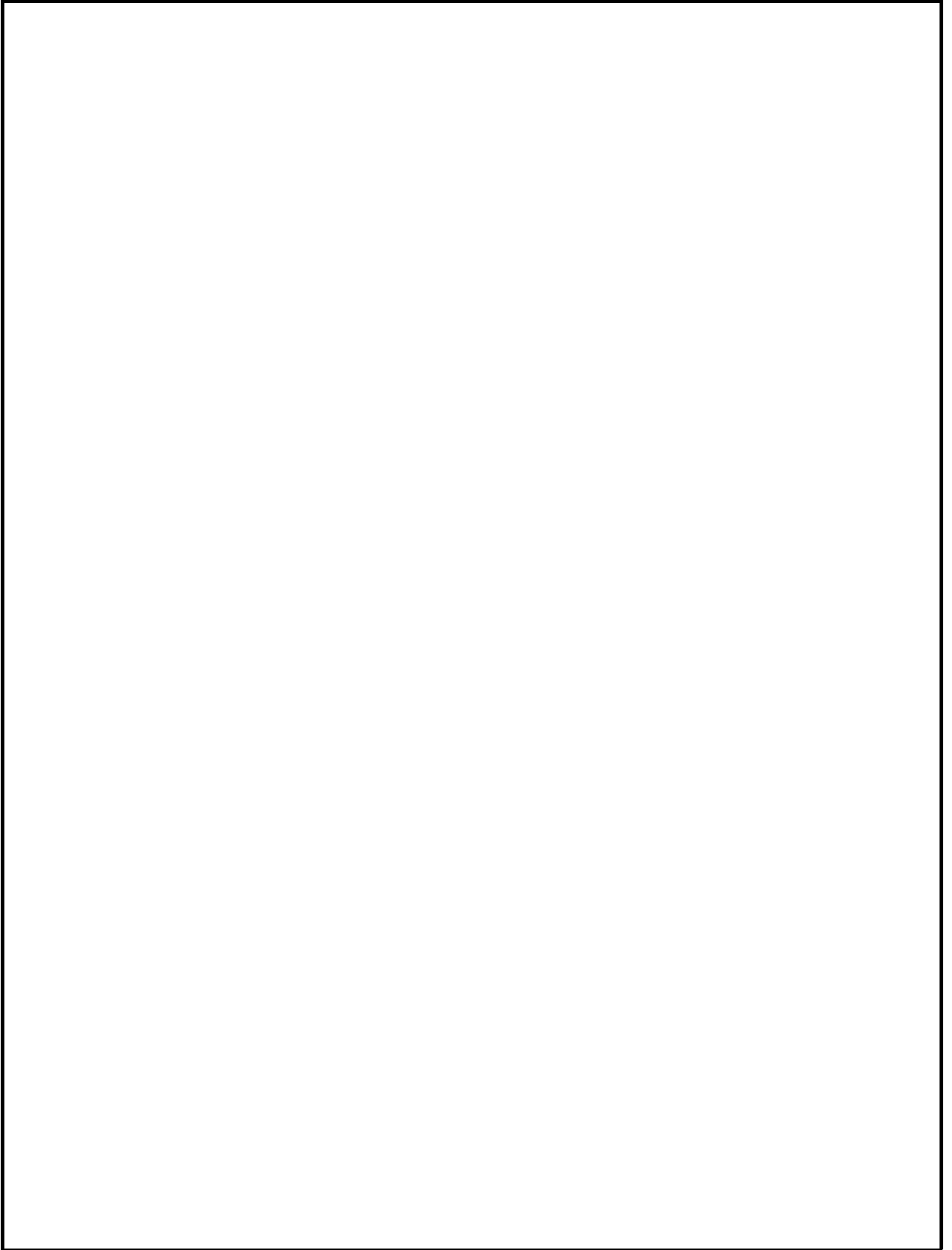

BACKGROUND:

The mission of the Parks Division of the Culver City Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department is to develop, maintain, rejuvenate, and repair at professional standards, all parks, landscaped median strips, parkways and other landscaped City facilities for the safety, health and welfare of the public. The Parks Division, currently headed by Parks Manager Patrick Reynolds, has a well-deserved reputation for performing excellent work in a timely manner while remaining responsive to the needs of the community. The PRCS Commission gets a first-hand view of the Parks Division's accomplishments each year during their tour of Culver City Parks and Facilities.
