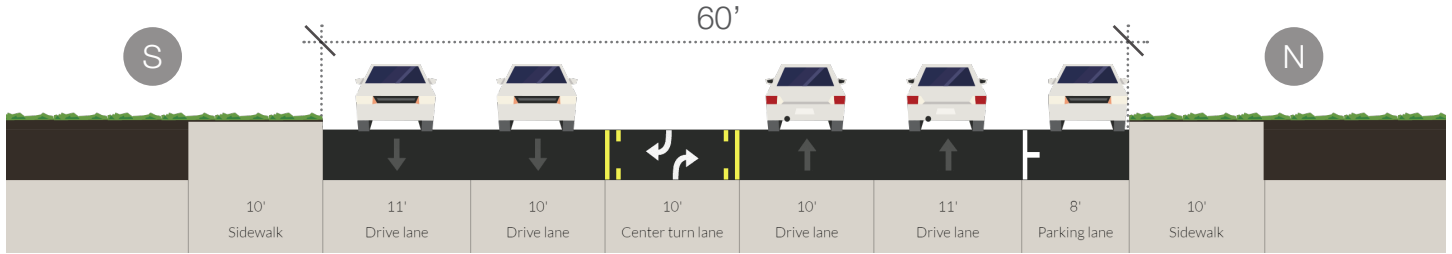

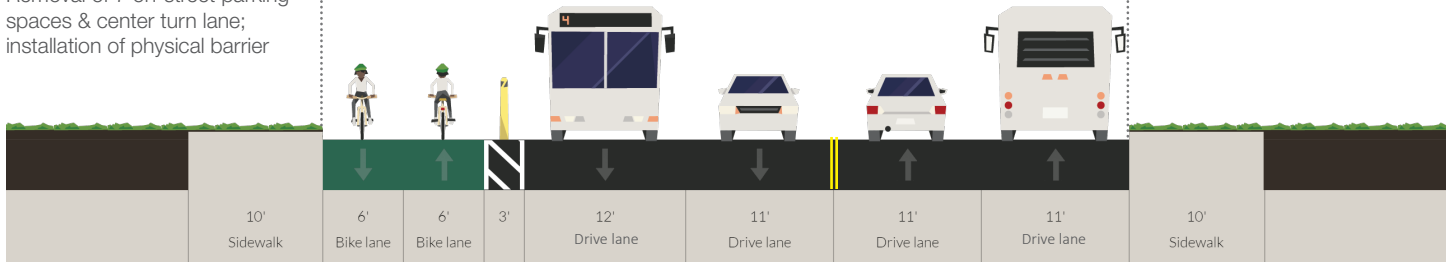

**Note:** There is some flexibility in designating the widths of the different cross sectional components.

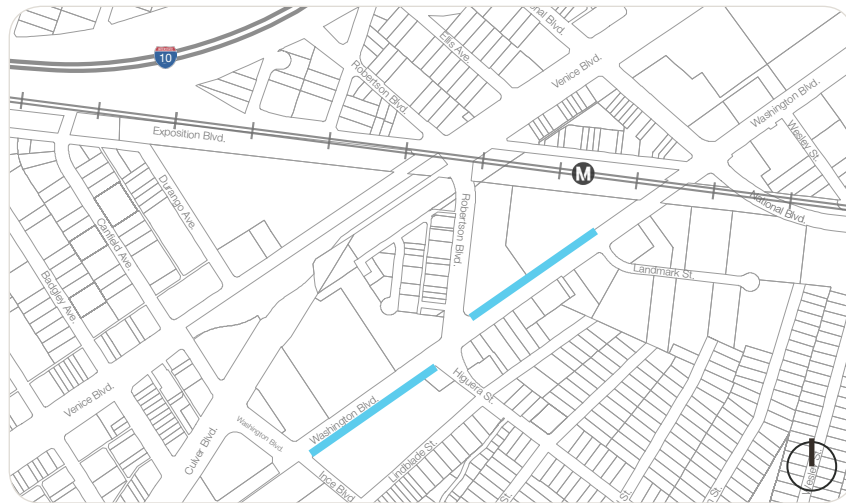
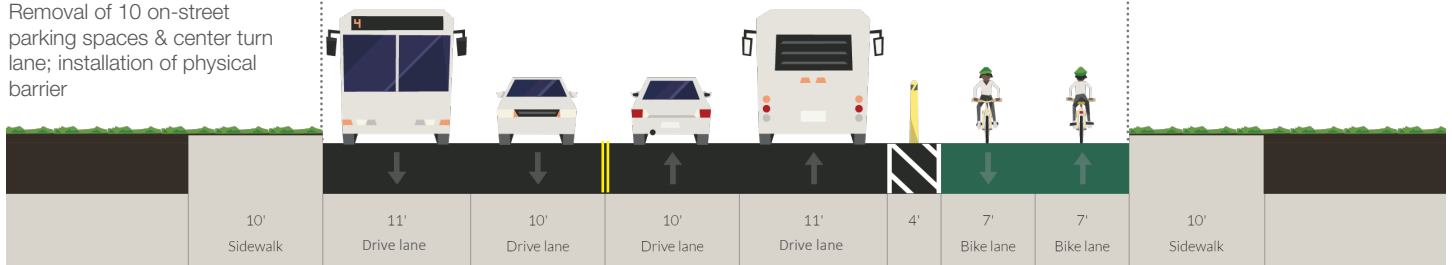
## INCE BLVD - ROBERTSON ST

## ROBERTSON ST - LANDMARK ST

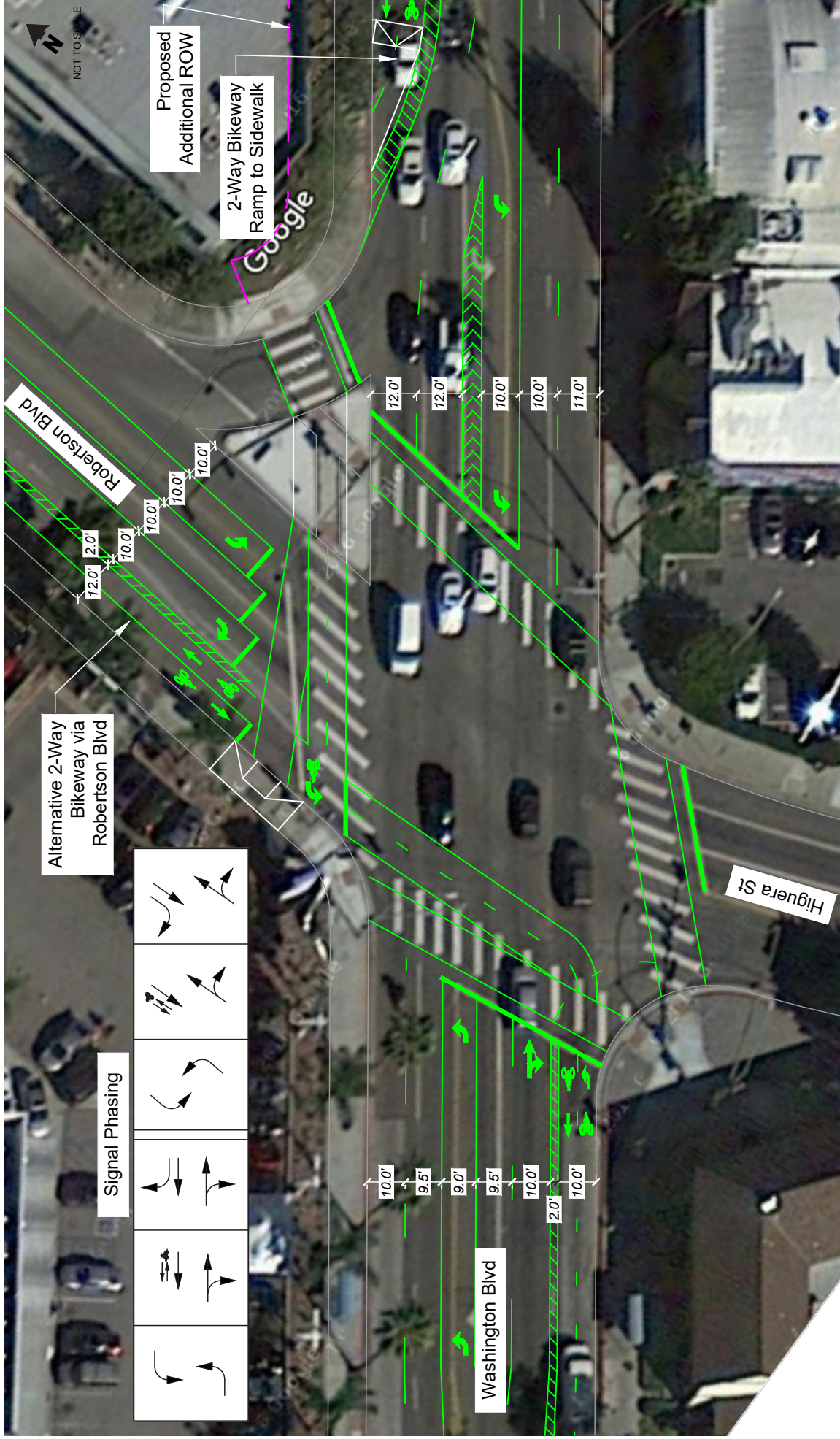
Removal of 10 on-street parking spaces & center turn lane; installation of physical barrier

**FIGURE 1. WASHINGTON BLVD at ROBERTSON BLVD**



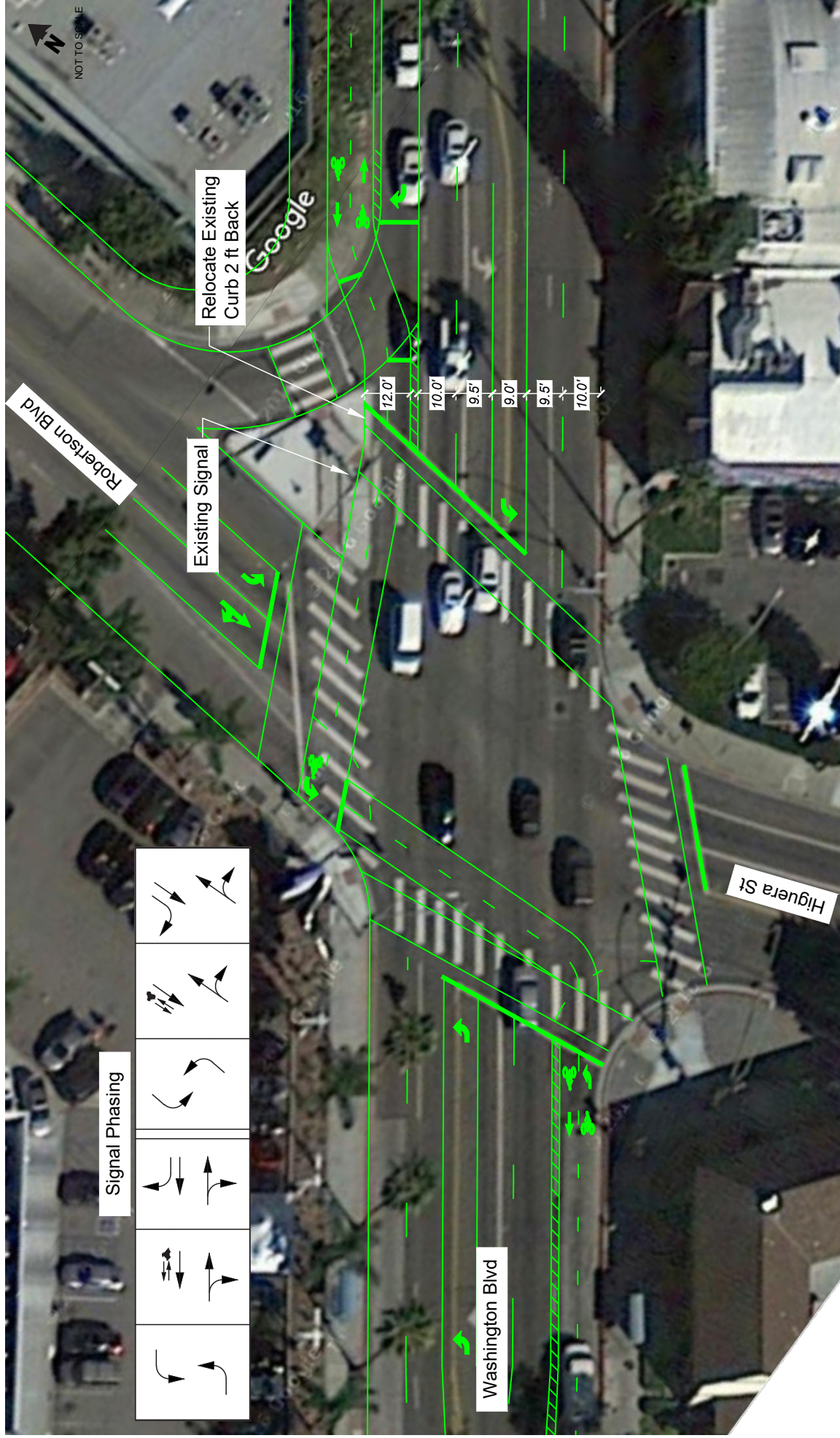

**FIGURE 2. WASHINGTON BLVD at ROBERTSON BLVD (FUTURE)**



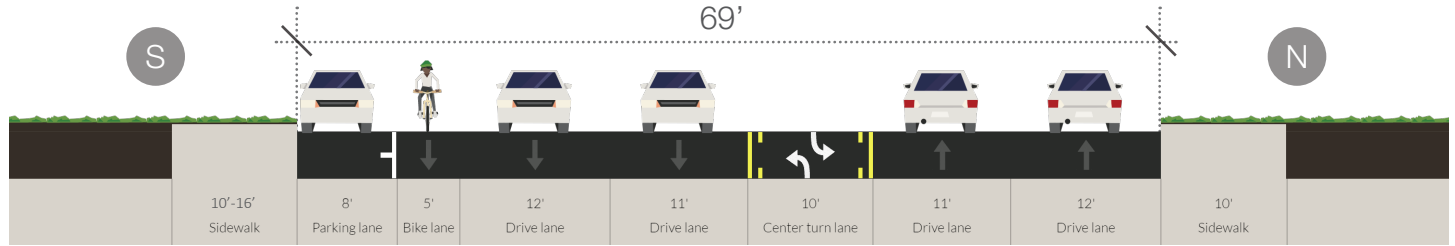

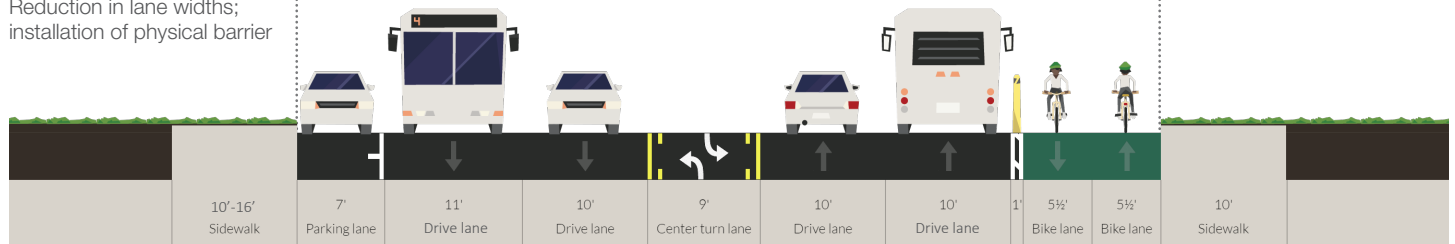

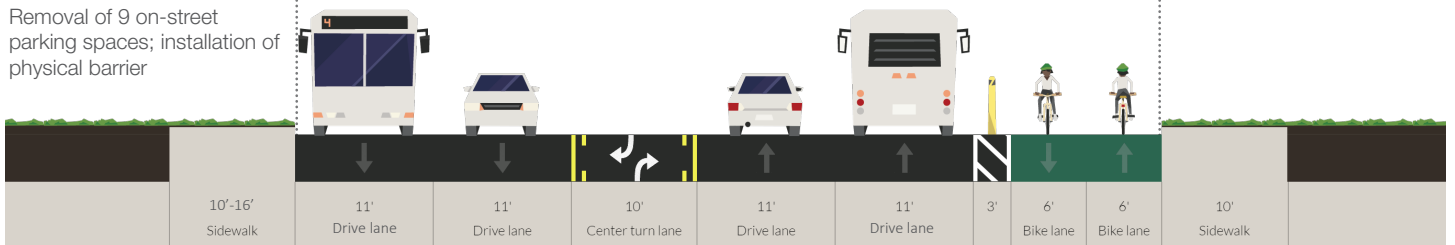

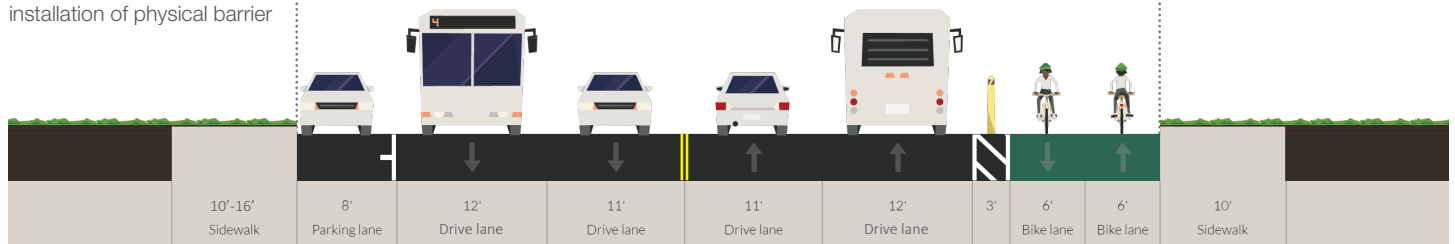

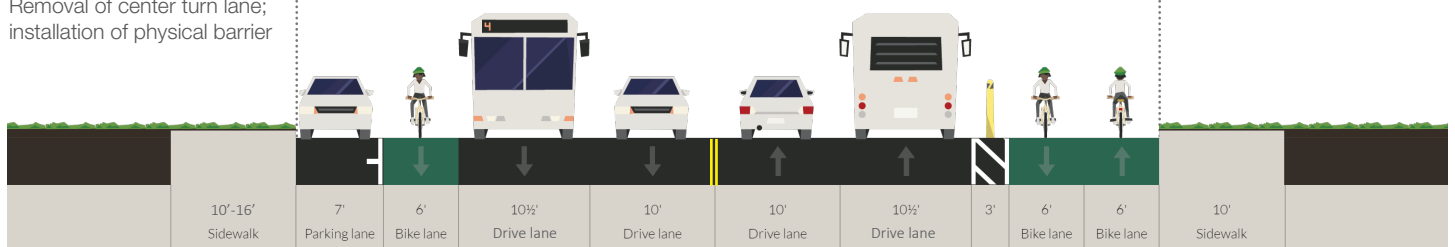

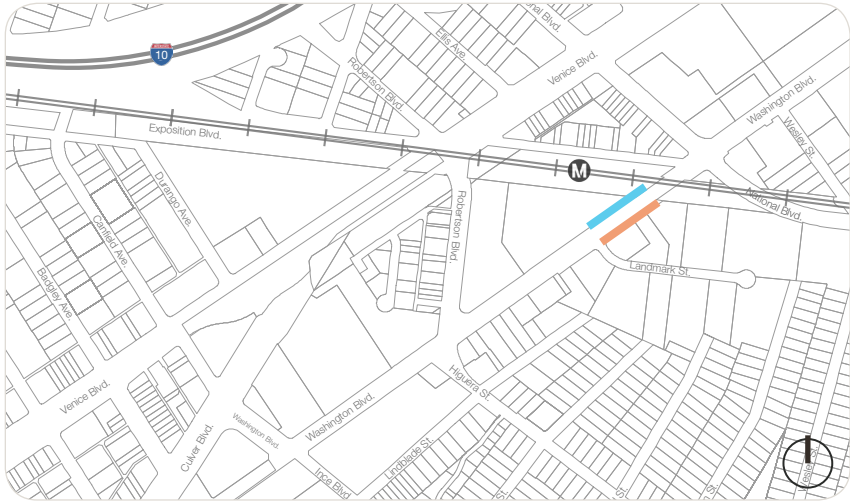

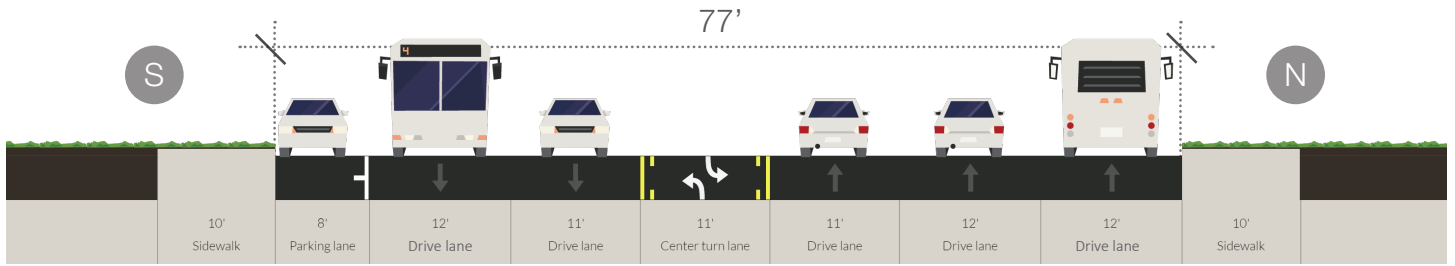

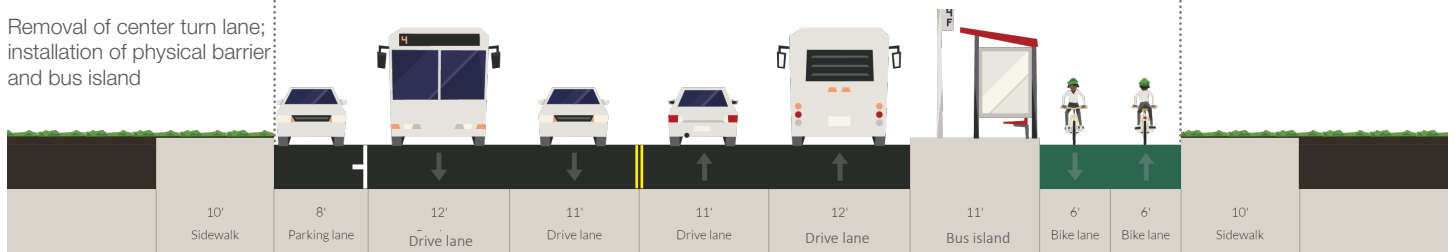

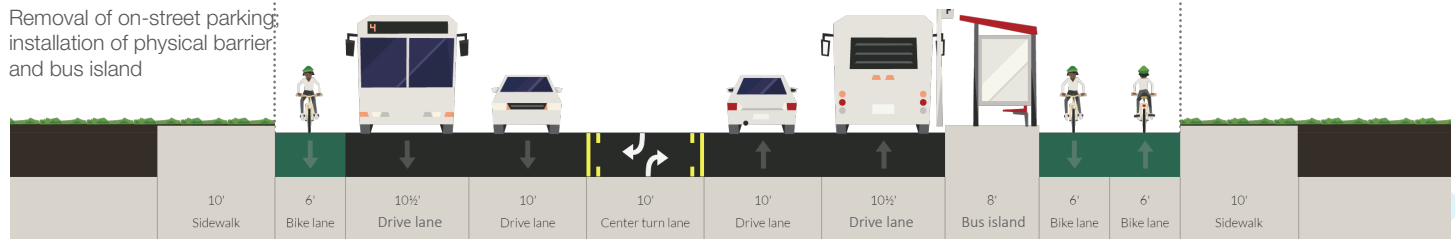

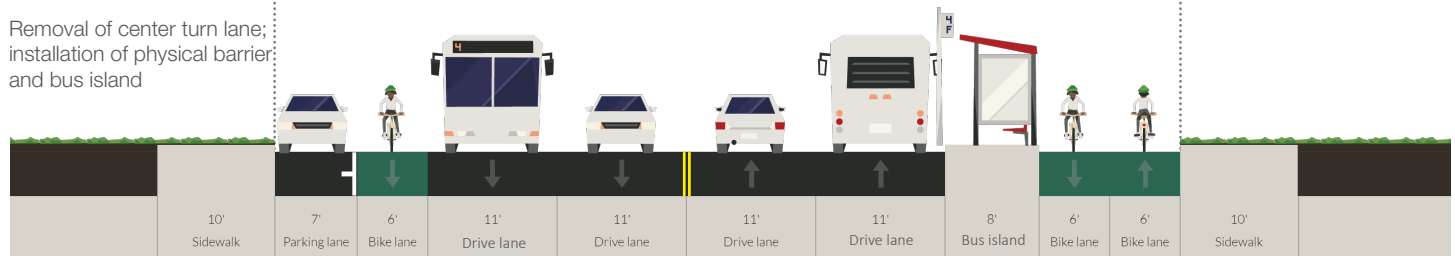

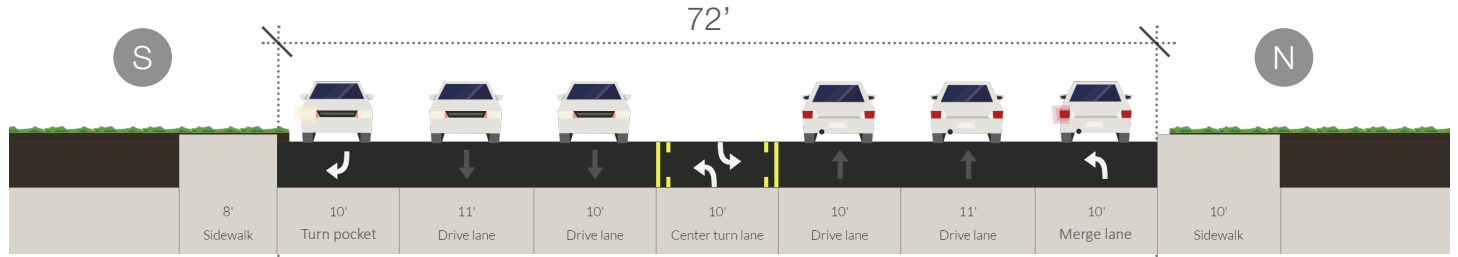

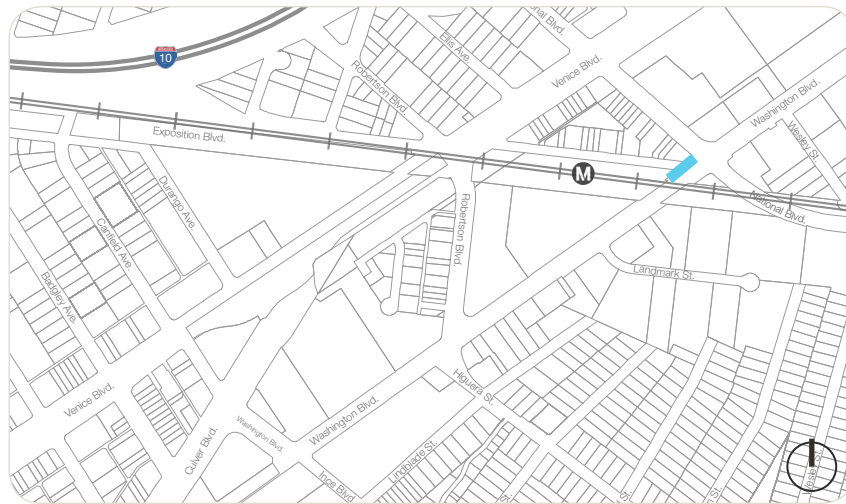
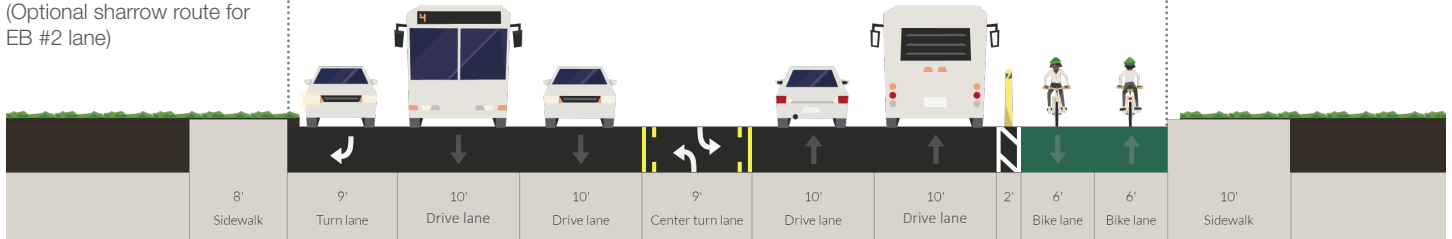

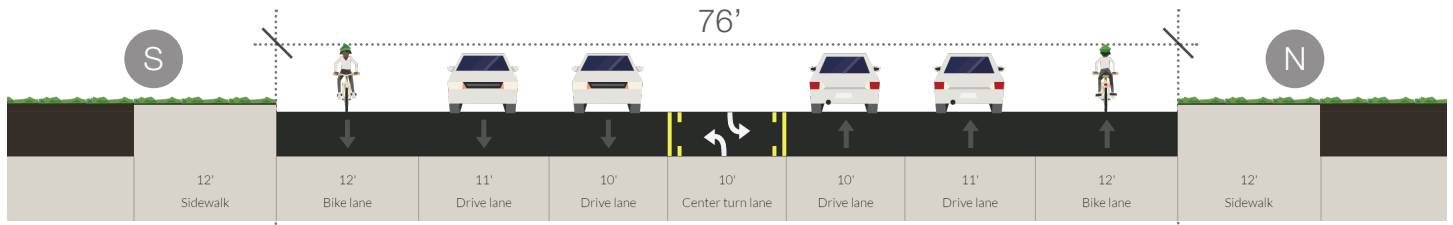

**Note:** As part of the development at 8777 Washington Blvd, the City will widen the roadway by 2 feet. There will be a required commercial loading zone to accommodate future trash service from the development and add on-street parking.

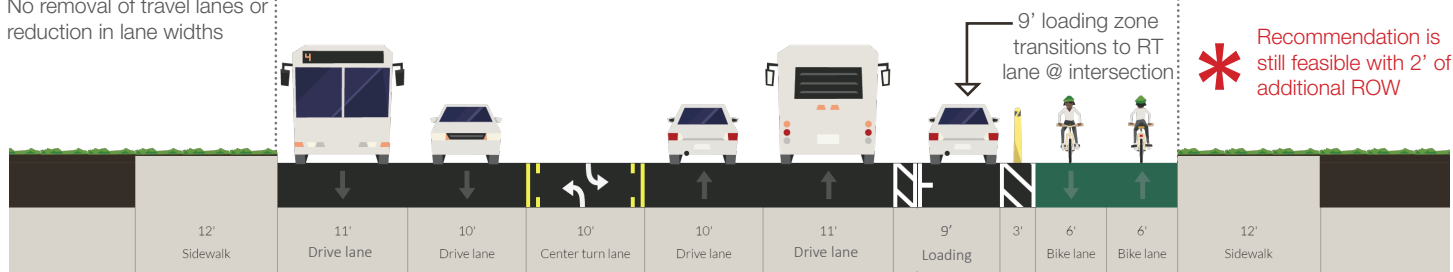

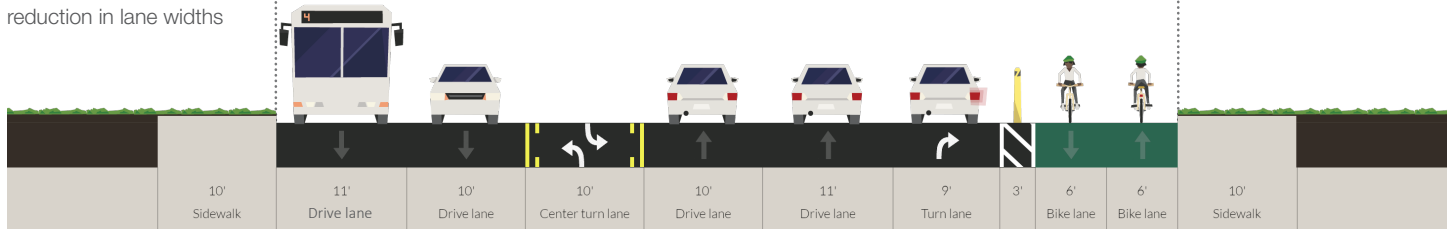

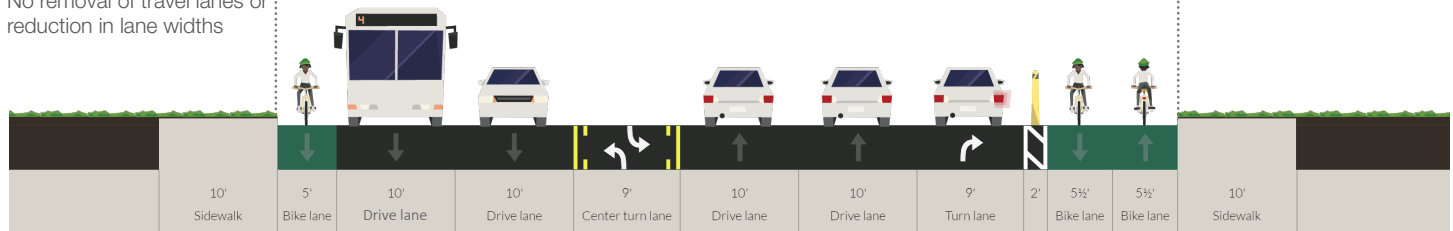

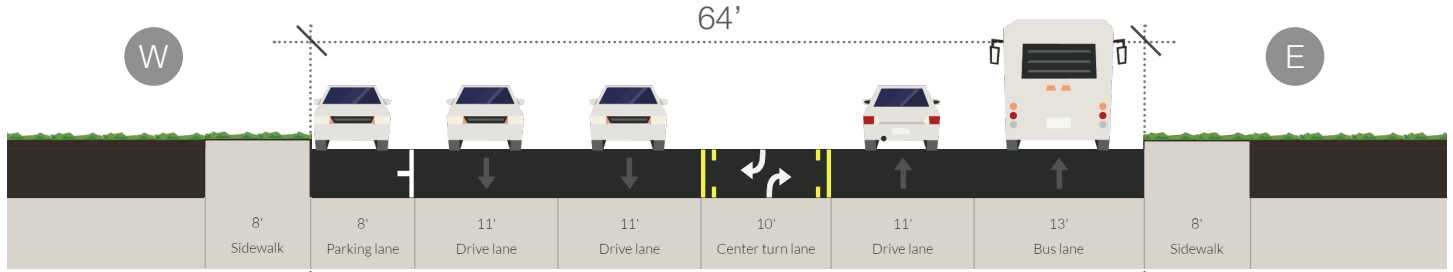

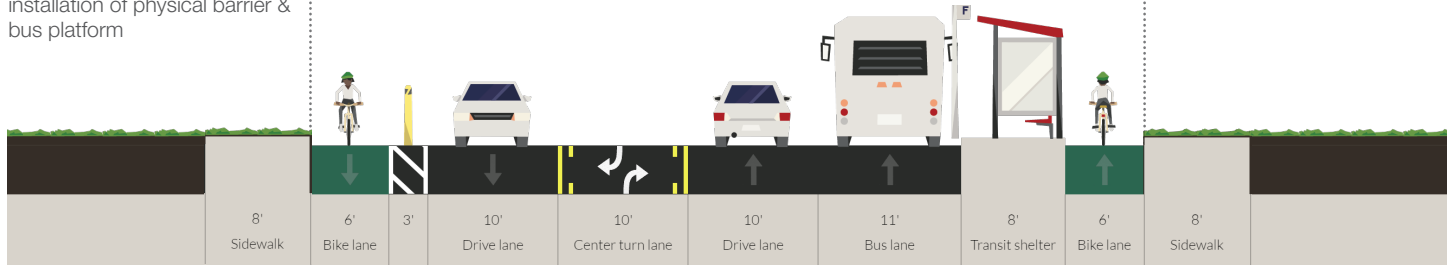

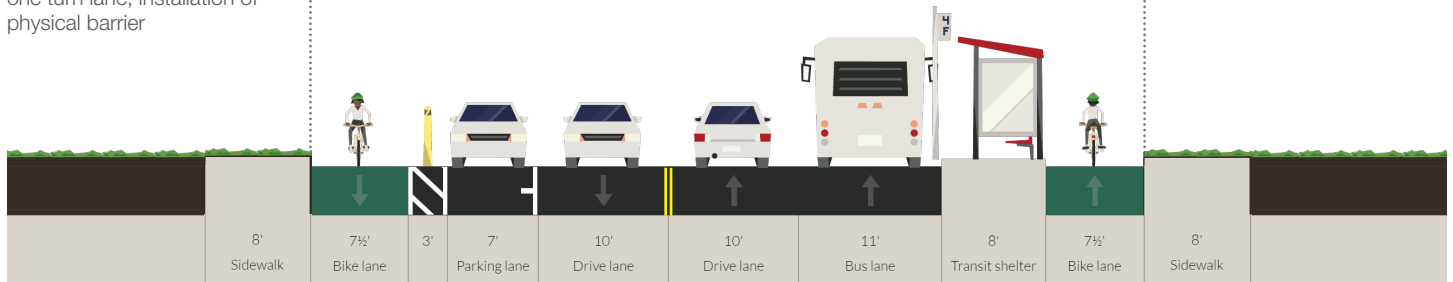

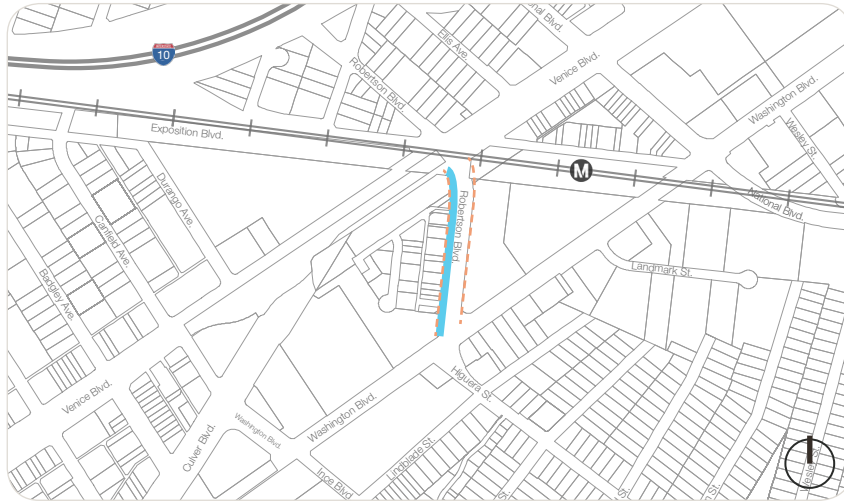
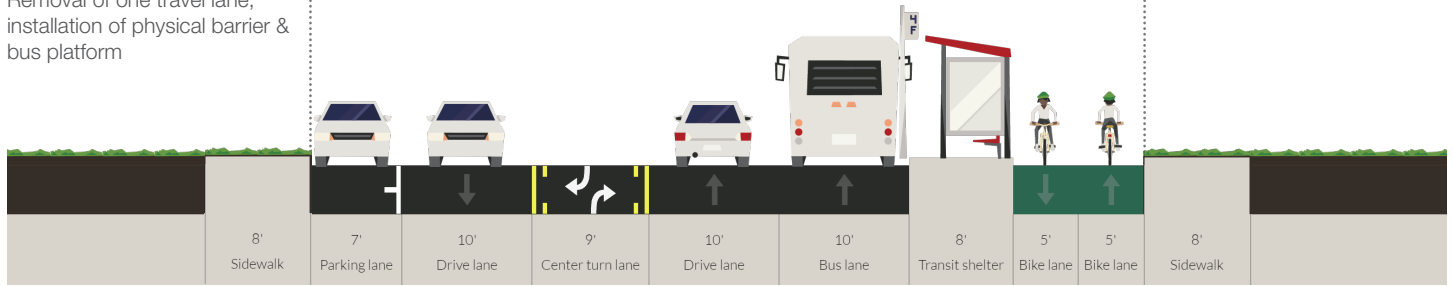
