A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, FIXING THE EMPLOYER'S
CONTRIBUTION UNDER THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES
MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT WITH RESPECT
TO THE CULVER CITY EMPLOYEES' ASSOCIATION AND
RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO 2004-R077

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 22892(a) provides that a local agency
contracting under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act shall fix the
amount of the employer's contribution at an amount not less than the amount required
under Section 22892(b) of the Act and

WHEREAS the City of Culver City (City), is a local agency contracting under
the Act for participation by members of the Culver City Employees' Association

NOW, THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES

for an employee or annuitant enrolled for self and two or more family members plus
administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund Assessments
