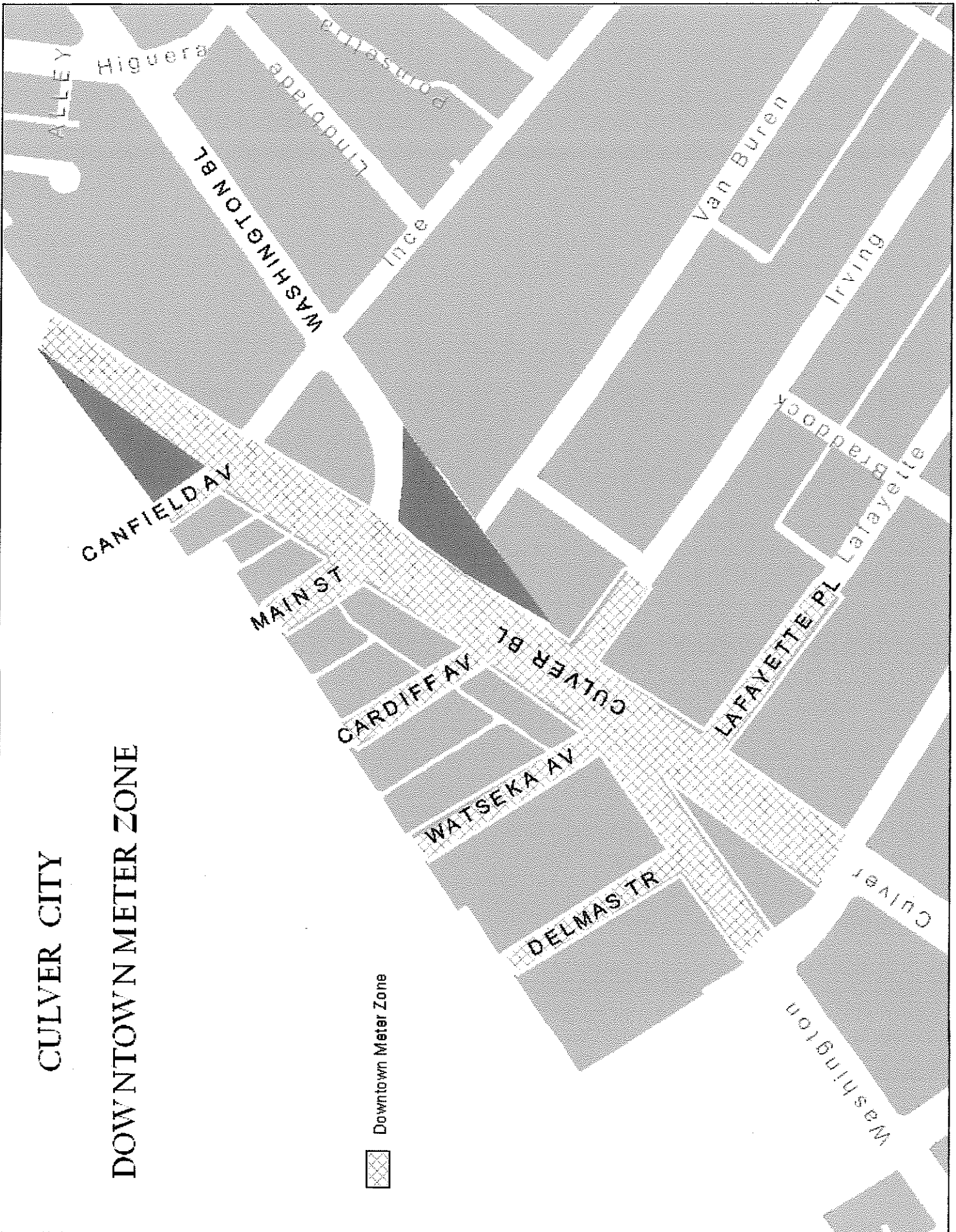

ORDINANCE NO. 2007-_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTIONS 7.03.500 AND 7.03.525 OF THE CULVER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE PERTAINING TO PARKING METER ZONES AND PARKING METER VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Culver City desires to establish a new parking meter zone, known as the Downtown Meter Zone ("DMZ"), in order to assist in the creation of an efficient parking system for Downtown; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the City Council to limit parking in the DMZ to two hours of continuous use and prohibit "meter feeding."

The City Council of the City of Culver City, California DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 7.03.500 is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

§ 7.03.500 PARKING METER ZONES.

The streets, portions of streets or areas hereinafter described within the City, are hereby defined and established as parking meter zones within which parking of vehicles shall be controlled and regulated with the aid of parking meters:

A. Those portions of the following streets within the City of Culver City:

1. Eastham Drive;
2. Hayden Avenue;
3. Hayden Place;
4. Higuera Avenue;
5. Hoke Avenue;
6. Hughes Avenue;
7. Landmark Street;

8. National Boulevard;
9. Robertson Boulevard;
10. Steller Drive;
11. Uplander Way;
12. Warner Drive;
13. Washington Place; and
14. Willat Avenue.

B. Those portions of the following streets between Washington Boulevard and Braddock Drive:

1. Duquesne Avenue;
2. Madison Avenue; and
3. Van Buren Street.

C. Those portions of the following streets between Culver Boulevard and Braddock Drive:

1. Lincoln Avenue.

D. Those portions of southbound Sepulveda Boulevard between:

1. Braddock Drive and Greenlawn Avenues; and
2. Sawtelle Boulevard and Jefferson Boulevard/Playa Street.

E. That portion of northbound Sepulveda Boulevard between Bush Way and Sawtelle Boulevard.

F. Those portions of westbound Washington Boulevard between:

1. La Cienega Boulevard and Hargis Street;
2. Sepulveda Boulevard and Globe Avenue;
3. Inglewood and Grandview Boulevards; and
4. Boise Avenue and Wade Street.

G. Those portions of eastbound Washington Boulevard between:

1. Kenyon Avenue and Centinela Avenue;
2. Grandview Boulevard and Lindblade Drive;
3. Inglewood Boulevard and Louise Avenue;

1 4. McLaughlin Avenue and Coolidge Avenue;

2 5. Purdue Avenue and Corinth Avenue; and

3 6. Sawtelle Boulevard and Huntley Avenue.

4 H. Adams Boulevard (northbound) between Fairfax Avenue and
Washington Boulevard.

5 I. Bristol Parkway (northbound) between Centinela Avenue and
Doverwood Drive.

6 J. Culver Boulevard between Elenda Street and Duquesne Avenue.

7 K. Fairfax Avenue (southbound) between Washington and Adams
8 Boulevards.

9 L. Hannum Avenue between Uplander Way and Buckingham Parkway.

10 M. Ince Boulevard between Venice Boulevard and Lucerne Avenue.

11 N. The north side of Jefferson Boulevard between Duquesne Avenue
12 and Overland Avenue.

13 O. Lindblade Street between Ince Boulevard and its easterly terminus.

14 P. Overland Avenue between Washington Boulevard and Farragut
Drive.

15 Q. Venice Boulevard between Midway Avenue and Overland Avenue.

16 R. Wesley Street between Washington Boulevard and National
17 Boulevard.

18 S. All municipal and Redevelopment Agency parking lots, used by the
19 general public, are hereby established as a parking meter zone unless monthly
charges are collected.

20 T. Those portions of the following streets within the City of Culver City
(which shall be known as the Downtown Meter Zone):

21 1. Cardiff Avenue;

22 2. Delmas Terrace;

23 3. Main Street;

24 4. Watseka Avenue;

25 5. Irving Place;

26 6. Culver Boulevard between Duquesne Avenue and Venice
27 Boulevard;

1 7. LaFayette Place; and

2 8. Those portions of Washington Boulevard between Hughes Avenue
3 and Watseka Avenue.

4 **SECTION 2.** Section 7.03.500 is hereby amended to read as follows

5 (additions indicated by underline; deletions indicated by ~~strikethrough~~):

6 **§ 7.03.525 UNLAWFUL TO PARK AFTER METER TIME HAS**
7 **EXPIRED OR BEYOND PARKING TIME LIMITS.**

8 A. No operator of any vehicle shall permit said vehicle to remain
9 parked in any parking space during any time that the meter is showing a signal
10 indicating that such space is illegally in use other than such time necessary for
11 the operator to comply with §7.03.515.

12 B. No operator of any vehicle shall permit said vehicle to remain
13 parked in any parking space for any time exceeding or beyond the period of legal
14 parking time established for any parking meter zone as herein described, or to
15 deposit in any parking meter any coin for the purpose of parking beyond the
16 maximum legal parking time for the particular parking meter zone.

17 **SECTION 3.** Pursuant to Section 619 of the City Charter, this Ordinance
18 shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption. Pursuant to Sections 616
19 and 621 of the City Charter, prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the
20 adoption, the City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance, or a summary thereof, to be
21 published in the Culver City News and shall post this Ordinance or a summary thereof
22 in at least three places within the City.

23 **SECTION 4.** The City Council hereby declares that, if any provision,
24 section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this ordinance is rendered
25 or declared invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court of competent
26 jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council would have

1 independently adopted the remaining provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs,
2 sentences, phrases or words of this ordinance and as such they shall remain in full
3 force and effect.

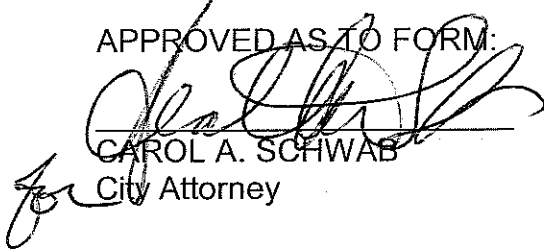

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-R_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING METER FEES
FOR PARKING METER ZONES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC") Section
7.03.520, the City Council may establish by resolution the parking meter fees for the
various parking meter zones within the City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to CCMC Section 7.03.520, such resolution shall
designate the zone, or section thereof, the amount of time and time period, and the time of
operation for the meters within such zone.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The parking meter fees for the parking meter zones established and
defined in Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC") Sections 7.03.500.A
through 7.03.500.S shall be fifty cents (\$0.50) per hour. All meters in
such zones shall be calibrated to display a one-half hour time period
for each twenty-five cents (\$0.25) deposited.
2. The parking meter fees for the parking meters located in the
Downtown Meter Zone ("DMZ"), as established and defined in CCMC
Section 7.03.500.T, shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) per hour. All meters in
the DMZ shall be calibrated to display a one-half hour time period for
each fifty cents (\$0.50) deposited.
3. The time of operation for parking meters in all parking meter zones
shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on every day except holidays or
as otherwise indicated by posted signs.

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4. This Resolution shall become effective concurrently upon the effective date of Ordinance No. 2007-_____.
