A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING \$32,273.00 IN URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR THE PURCHASE OF TACTICAL EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES EQUIPMENT, AND PROVIDING PROOF OF AUTHORITY AS REQUIRED BY THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF EMERGENCY SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, Grants Program Directorate, (DHS) through its Office of Grants and Training, provides financial assistance to the Urban Area Security Initiative (UASI) Grant Program through the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES) to address unique equipment, training, organization, exercise and planning needs to assist emergency personnel throughout the state to build effective prevention and protection capabilities to prevent, respond to, and recover from threats or acts of terrorism; and

WHEREAS, on September 1, 2024, the DHS made a federal award to UASI with a subaward performance period of September 1, 2024, to August 31, 2027; and

WHEREAS, Cal OES provides funds to various California counties and regions, including the Los Angeles/Long Beach Urban Area (LA/LBUA) through the City of Los Angeles Mayor's Office of Public Safety, as its Subgrantees, with said funds being distributed by the counties to other specified jurisdictions within each region; and

WHEREAS, in the 2024 regional application for UASI funds, the Culver City Fire Department (CCFD) included a request for funding for tactical emergency medical services equipment; and

WHEREAS, the City of Los Angeles notified CCFD that the City of Culver City, as a Subrecipient, was awarded the amount of \$32,273.00 to purchase the

1 equipment, and the City of Culver City now desires to accept the 2024 UASI grant funds
2 from the City of Los Angeles; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the performance period for the project ends on May 31, 2027;
4 and

5 **WHEREAS**, as a requirement of obtaining the 2024 UASI grant funds, the
6 City Council must provide written Proof of Authority in support of the Project for which the
7 UASI grant funds will be used, and agree to the provisions of the 2024 Grant
8 Assurances.

10 **NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Culver City **DOES**
11 **HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:

12 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and supports the CCFD Project for
13 which CCFD will use the 2024 UASI grant funds.

14 2. By the adoption of this Resolution, the City Council provides this Proof
15 of Authority as required by the Cal OES Standard Assurances and agrees as
16 follows:
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18 (a) To provide all matching funds required for the grant
19 project and that any cash match will be appropriated as
20 required;

21 (b) Any liability arising out of the performance of this
22 agreement shall be the responsibility of the Applicant City,
23 and the City Council, as the authorized governing body of
24 the City;
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(c) Grant funds shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by the City Council, governing board, or authorized body; and

(d) The City Manager, who is the official executing the agreement is, in fact, authorized to do so.
