1 2. The names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City
2 Council are as follows: Micheál (Mehaul) O'Leary, Jeff Cooper, Gary Russell, Luther L.
3 Henderson III, Randy Scott Leslie, Andrew Weissman, Christopher R. Armenta, Cary Bert
4 Anderson, and Loni Anderson.

5 3. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes
6 given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective office for which the
7 persons were candidates are as listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part
8 hereof.
9

10 4. The City Council does declare and determine that Andrew Weissman
11 is elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; Christopher
12 Armenta is elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four years; and
13 Micheál (Mehaul) O'Leary is elected as Member of the City Council for the full term of four
14 years.
15

16 5. The measure voted upon at the election is as follows:

17 Measure W: "Shall an Ordinance be adopted to modernize the City's Utility
18 Users' Tax, at the existing rate: To preserve funding of general city services, such as
19 police, fire, streets, trees, and parks; to reflect technological advances in communications;
20 to treat taxpayers equally regardless of technology used; to retain existing exemptions for
21 low-income seniors and the disabled; and to require an annual independent audit?"
22

23 6. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes
24 given in the City to the measure above named is listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and
25 made a part hereof.

26 7. As a result of the election, a majority of voters voting on Measure W
27 voted in favor of it and the Measure was carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

1 8. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City
2 of Culver City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) the whole number of
3 ballots cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons for which voters cast their ballots; (3)
4 the Measure voted upon; (4) the office into which each person was voted; (5) the number
5 of votes given at each precinct to each person, and for and against the Measure; and (6)
6 the total number of votes given to each person and for and against the Measure.

7 9. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the
8 persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated.
9 The City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in
10 the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in
11 the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted
12 into the respective office to which they have been selected.

13 10. The City Clerk shall immediately codify the complete text of Measure
14 W adopted by the voters into the Culver City Municipal Code and perform such other duties
15 related to said Measure as required by law..

17 11. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this
18 resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

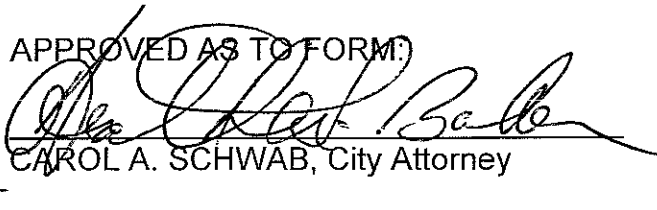
