<u>RECOMMENDATION:</u> Staff recommends the City Council conduct a public hearing and adopt a Resolution approving the Engineer's Report and ordering the assessment levy for the Albright Street Lighting Assessment District for Fiscal Year July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007. <u>PROCEDURE:</u> Mayor: Announce that this is the time and place for the public hearing to discuss the annual levy of assessments for the Albright Avenue Street Lighting Assessment District for Fiscal Year 2006/2007. City Clerk: Announce that notice of this hearing has been given pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 15.01 of the Culver City Municipal Code, and pursuant to the provisions of the City Council's Resolution 2006-R033 and in accordance with Articles XIII C and D of the California Constitution, known as the "Right to Vote on Taxes Act" (Proposition 218) and the 1972 Landscape and Lighting Assessment District Act and that the following affidavits are on file in his office:	

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1. Affidavit of Publication; and
2. Affidavit of Posting.

Mayor and Council: Motion to receive and file all affidavits.

City Engineer: Present the Engineer's Report and explain method of assessment for the annual levy.

City Clerk: Announce the number of written protests received, if any, and announce that copies of all such protests have been delivered to the City Council OR, summarize the contents thereof.

Mayor: First, ask to hear from those who have filed a written protest. Next, ask to hear from those in the audience wishing to speak against the proposed assessments.

Then, ask to hear from anyone who wishes to speak in favor of the proposed assessments.

Mayor and Council: Declare the Public Hearing CLOSED.

Mayor and Council: Discussion.

Mayor and Council: By Motion, overrule and deny any protests, assuming protests represent less than 50% of property interest.

Mayor and Council: By Motion, adopt the Resolution approving the Engineer's Report and confirming the assessments and the diagrams of the District.

BACKGROUND:

Location map is included in the Engineer's Report and is labeled "Exhibit C."

The assessment for the District includes costs for providing construction, plans and specifications and City staff time for the installation of five streetlights and the appurtenant underground power distribution.

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DISCUSSION

On May 8, 2006, the City Council ordered the preparation of the Engineer's Report, declared its intention to order the assessment levy and set the date, time and place for this public hearing per Resolution No. 2006-R033.

The total cost incurred for the improvements was \$53,152 which was the basis for the subject assessment levy. The costs to be assessed during each fiscal year beginning in the 2005/06 Fiscal Year will be \$6,552.00, including in Fiscal Year 2006/2007.

If there is a majority protest for the annual assessment, Council can still impose the assessment levy with a 4/5ths majority vote. Also, Council could, by 4/5ths majority vote, suspend collection of that assessment and pay for the improvements through appropriations from the City's General Fund.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

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The Albright Avenue Street Lighting Assessment District budget is 100 percent self-supporting for all expenditures related to the street lighting installation improvements. Property owners within the District are charged for their fair share of these costs, as described in the Engineer's Report. The cost of operations and maintenance are assumed by the City as part of the City's street lighting system grid.
