1 RESOLUTION NO. 2009-R_____

2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE
4 SCHEDULE OF FARES FOR THE CULVER CITY
5 MUNICIPAL BUS LINES AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION
6 NO. 2000-R118.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
8 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

9 1. The following fare schedule is hereby adopted for all scheduled routes of
10 the Culver City Municipal Bus Lines, effective August 24, 2009 at 2:00 AM.

11 A. The adult bus fares shall be one dollar (\$1.00) per fare. Such fare
12 may be paid in cash or by presenting a TAP card.

13 B. The student bus fare for kindergarten through high school
14 students (12th Grade), shall be seventy-five cents (\$0.75). Such fare may be
15 paid in cash by students presenting a currently validated identification card
16 issued by a recognized educational institution or by presenting a student TAP
17 card.

19 C. The bus fare for senior citizens, 62 years or more of age, and
20 disabled persons, other than the blind, presenting a valid identification card
21 issued by the federal or state government, or by the City of Culver City shall pay
22 thirty-five cents (\$0.35). A senior or disabled TAP card may also be used for
23 payment.

25 D. Free transportation shall be provided on all regularly scheduled
26 buses of the Culver City Municipal Bus Lines for all City employees and for all

1 blind persons within the definition of the California Welfare and Institutions
2 Code §19153, whose blindness has been certified as required by said Section.

3 E. The fare for an intra-line transfer shall be ten cents (\$0.10) for
4 senior citizens and disabled persons and twenty-five cents (\$0.25) for all
5 others.

6 F. The fare for a local transfer shall be twenty cents (\$0.20) for
7 senior citizens and disabled persons and forty cents for all others (\$0.40).

9 2. All definitions contained in the City of Culver City Transportation
10 Program for the Elderly and Handicapped, as approved and adopted by Resolution No. CS-
11 7480, shall apply herein.

12 3. Resolution No. 2000-R118 is hereby rescinded.

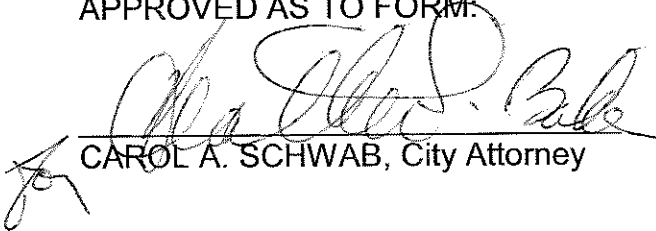
