3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
4 OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE
5 PROPOSITION 1B LOCAL STREETS AND ROADS
6 FUNDING PROPOSALS.

7 WHEREAS, on November 7, 2006, the voters of the State of California
8 passed Proposition 1B, which authorized the State of California to issue \$19.9 billion in
9 general obligation bonds to fund state and local transportation improvement and related
10 projects; and

11 WHEREAS, the City of Culver City is entitled to receive at least \$656,111
12 from this funding source to improve and maintain local streets and roads in the City; and

13 WHEREAS, the State's Department of Finance requires cities to submit a
14 plan of City Council approved projects to be funded by this source.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
16 DOES RESOLVE as follows:

17 1. Pursuant to the recommendation of the Director of Public Works/City
18 Engineer and the City Manager, the City Council hereby approves the "Proposition 1B
19 Local Streets and Roads Funding Proposals" as contained in "Exhibit A" which is attached
