## RESOLUTION NO. 2015-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, SUSPENDING THE COLLECTION OF BUSINESS TAXES, AS SET FORTH IN CULVER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 11.01.250, FOR ITINERANT MOTION PICTURE/TELEVISION PRODUCERS.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Culver City finds that the film and production industry is of significant importance to the City's local economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council supports the City remaining competitive and attractive to film production companies and creating an atmosphere that continues to foster the film and production industry in the long-term; and

WHEREAS, in order to further this goal, the City Council has considered options for a business tax structure that would be more favorable to production companies and continue to encourage activity at local studios located within Culver City, thereby stimulating the City's local economy; and

WHEREAS, in light of the importance of the film industry in Culver City and the positive economic impact, job retention and job creation that occurs through increased filming in the City, on February 7, 2011 the City Council approved a five-year suspension of the collection of business taxes on itinerant motion picture/television producers as a means to stimulate the City's local economy; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, at its regular meeting of September 28, 2015, reached consensus to extend the suspension an additional 10 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The suspension of the collection of business taxes on itinerant motion picture/television producers, pursuant to Culver City Municipal Code Section 11.01.250, shall be extended for an additional period of 10 years (the "Tax Suspension").

1	2. For purposes of this Resolution, "itinerant motion picture/television
2	producers" do not include motion picture/television producers that occupy property within
3	Culver City which they own, or occupy through a lease or rental agreement in excess of
4	365 days.
5	3. The extended Tax Suspension shall become effective on February 8,
6	2016 and shall automatically expire on February 8, 2026, unless earlier terminated or
7	extended by another resolution of the City Council.
8	4. During the 10-year Tax Suspension period, the Chief Financial Officer
9	shall make best efforts to solicit impacts on local spending and employment as a result of
10	filming activity from Culver City media production facilities.
