Update on event preparations:

We found out that a college and career fair is to be held at CCHS on Tue, 9/17/24 at the same time as this event. This fair is a major event at the high school that most of the student body and their families attend. We believe that having our Race Relations dialogue event at the same time as this fair at CCHS will have a big negative impact on the attendance at our event. As such our event ad hoc subcommittee proposes that our event be postponed to October 2024.

Ideally, the event can be rescheduled for Tue, October 1st or 15th at 6pm to 9pm.

This would allow us to still incorporate the Latino Heritage Month Speaker into our event (10/15 being the last day of Latino Heritage Month).

In this scenario, the program would focus on the race relations dialogue from 6pm to 8pm. And then we would have a special presentation on Latino Heritage Month from 8pm to 9pm.

Our choosing either of these as our final event date would be contingent upon the availability of Mayor McMorrin as one of our speakers, along with the availability of a desirable event location.

If 10/1/24 or 10/15/24 don't work, our **next preference would be to schedule the event on Tue, October 29th at 6pm to 8:30pm.**

NOTE: In this scenario we will not be able to incorporate the Latino Heritage Month Speaker presentation.

Proposed Budget: Up to \$100 for Snacks & drinks.
