
# **CULVER CITY MEASURE CC AND C**

## DISTRICT TAXES UPDATE

**4Q 2024 (OCTOBER-DECEMBER)** 







### **CULVER CITY DISTRICT TAXES HIGHLIGHTS**

Culver City Measures C and CC's gross receipts from October through December 2024 were 2.3% above the fourth sales period in 2023. However, after adjusting for reporting modifications such as audit adjustments and delayed payments, actual sales were up 1.1%. Results varied among tax groups.

Even with increased ecommerce purchases by residents, consumers were more cautious during the busy shopping months, and general consumer goods declined 2.6%. The price of crude oil fell during the period and directly affected fuel-service station receipts – with revenues sliding 12%. The food-drug group also slumped during the period.

On the positive, most segments of the restaurants-hotels group posted higher returns, boosting the group 4.2% as people enjoyed the

convenience and experience of dining out and visiting the area. New car purchases by City residents improved and autos-transportation jumped 5%. Increased contractor activity and plumbing/electrical supply sales netted building-construction positive results.

Gains in business services and office equipment sales lifted business-industry into positive territory. A large, one-time taxpayer payment boosted the transfers & receivables group by a whopping 179% and constributing to the overall positive result for the quarter.

Net of adjustments, taxable sales for all of Los Angeles County declined 2.8% over the comparable time period; the Southern California region was down 1.2%.


