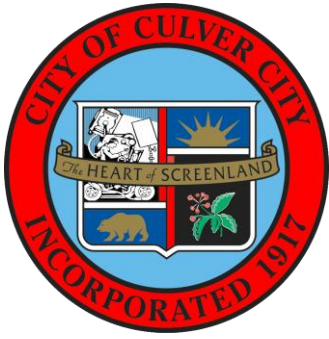

DISABILITY ADVISORY COMMITTEE REGULAR MEETING Wednesday, February 11, 2015 6:30 p.m.

PUBLIC COMMENT: At the times provided on the Agenda, the Disability Advisory Committee (DAC) will receive comments from the public on any item of interest to the public (not listed on the agenda) that is within the subject matter jurisdiction of the DAC. The DAC cannot legally take action on any item not appearing on the agenda. Such items may be referred for administrative action or scheduled on a future agenda. If you wish to address the DAC, staff liaison requests you complete a Speaker's Card and present it to staff before the agenda item is called. You will be called to speak when it is your turn to address the DAC. Providing your name and other information requested on the Speaker's Card is voluntary and is requested only to provide a reasonable means to notify persons when their opportunity to address the DAC has arrived. All persons may attend the meeting regardless of whether a person signs, registers, or completes a speaker's card. For specific items listed on the agenda, requests to address the DAC must be made prior to the calling for a vote on that particular item by the presiding officer. Each speaker may address the DAC for up to three minutes (up to four minutes if time is ceded). Persons who are present in the DAC meeting may cede one minute of time to one other person who is present and wishes to address the DAC by presenting a Speaker's Card to the City Clerk. Public comments on items on the agenda are taken at the time that particular agenda item is considered by the DAC.

AUTHORITY OF PRESIDING OFFICER: Section 611 of the City Charter provides that during any public meeting, all persons shall have the right to address the City Council, and any City commission, board or committee, subject to reasonable rules of decorum and time limits established by ordinance or the presiding officer. Therefore the presiding officer may, from time to time, establish different time limits than those listed in this Agenda in order to effectively conduct City business.

AVAILABILITY OF AGENDA PACKETS AND CONSERVATION OF RESOURCES: Copies of the Agenda and other materials relating to agenda items are available in the room where the meeting takes place. Members of the public may inspect (at no cost) and/or obtain copies (upon payment of the City's current copying fee) of any regular session item by visiting the City Clerk's Office at City Hall. The City also posts this information on its website (www.culvercity.org) as a courtesy.

CELL PHONES AND OTHER DISTRACTIONS: Use of cell phones, pagers and other communication devices is prohibited while the meeting is in session. Please turn all devices off or place on silent alert and leave the meeting area to use. During the meeting, please refrain from applause or other actions that may be disruptive to the speakers or the conduct of City business.

MEETING INFORMATION AND ACCOMODATION: DAC meetings are regularly scheduled for the second Wednesday of every even month (February, April, June, August, October and December). DAC Agenda information is available at least 72 hours before each DAC meeting. Any person needing reasonable accommodation related to disabilities, including assisted listening devices, is welcome to contact the Disability Services Office at 310-253-6729.
