3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
4 OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE
5 ENGINEER'S REPORT AND ORDERING THE
6 ASSESSMENT LEVY FOR THE LANDSCAPING
7 MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1, ZONE 1 FOR FISCAL
8 YEAR 2010-2011.

9 WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Culver City has previously
10 ordered the formation of a landscape Assessment district pursuant to the provisions of
11 Chapter 15.01 of the Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC") for a street landscape district
12 to be known and designated as "Landscaping Maintenance District No. 1, Zone 1"
13 (hereinafter referred to as the "Assessment District"); and

14 WHEREAS, on May 24, 2010, by resolution, the City Council declared its
15 intention to order the annual assessment levy, to collect the assessments, and to carry
16 on all other proceedings necessary for the levy of annual assessments for the
17 Assessment District; and ordered the City Engineer to prepare a Report on the Annual
18 Levy 2010-2011, Landscaping Maintenance District No. 1, Zone 1 (the "Engineer's
19 Report") to be filed with the City Clerk and submitted to the City Council for consideration
20 at a public hearing on June 14, 2010; and

21 WHEREAS, the public hearing scheduled for June 14, 2010 was continued
22 on two occasions to August 9, 2010; and

23 WHEREAS, the City Engineer prepared and filed the Engineer's Report
24 (attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference) for the City
25 Council's consideration; and

1 WHEREAS, the City Council has heard all testimony and evidence at a duly
2 noticed public hearing held on August 9, 2010 and has determined to proceed with the
3 proposed levy of annual assessment for the Assessment District through fiscal year
4 2010-2011.

5 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES
6 HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

7 1. Upon the conclusion of the public hearing, written protests filed and
8 not withdrawn did not represent property owners owning more than fifty percent (50%) of
9 the area of assessable lands within the Assessment District.

10 2. The Engineer's Report is hereby approved and the annual levy of the
11 Assessment District, as set forth and described in the Engineer's Report, is hereby
12 ordered.

13 3. The diagram and proposed assessments as set forth and contained
14 in the Engineer's Report are hereby confirmed and adopted.

15 4. The adoption of this Resolution constitutes the levy of proposed
16 assessments for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2010 and ending June 30, 2011.

17 5. The estimates of costs, the assessment diagram, the proposed
18 assessments, and all other matters as set forth in the Engineer's Report as submitted
19 pursuant to CCMC §15.01.055, are hereby approved and adopted.

20 6. The proposed assessments for improvements as set forth in the
21 Engineer's Report shall be performed pursuant to law. The County Auditor shall enter on
22 the County Assessment Roll the amount of the assessment and the assessment shall be
23 collected at the same time and in the same manner as the County property taxes are

1 collected. After collection by the County, the net amount of the assessment shall be paid
2 to the City Treasurer of the City of Culver City.

3 7. Upon receipt of monies representing assessments collected by the
4 County, the City Treasurer for the City of Culver City shall deposit the monies into a
5 special fund known as the "Fund for Landscaping Maintenance District No. 1, Zone 1,
6 Assessment," which was previously established upon the creation of the Assessment
7 District.
8

9 8. Immediately upon the adoption of this Resolution, the City Clerk shall
10 file a certified copy of this Resolution, which includes the Engineer's Report containing
11 the diagram and proposed assessments, with the County Auditor.

12 9. A certified copy of the Engineer's Report shall also be filed in the
13 Office of the City Engineer, with a duplicate copy on file in the Office of the City Clerk,
14 and shall be open for public inspection.

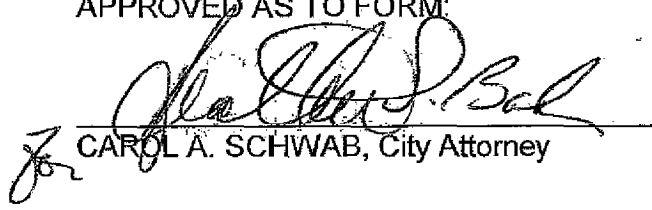

RESOLUTION NO. 2010-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO DISSOLVE LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1, ZONE 2 AND ORDER THE ZONE FUND BALANCE TO BE RETURNED TO THE DISTRICT PROPERTY OWNERS, AND SETTING THE TIME AND PLACE FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Culver City desires to conduct proceedings for considering the dissolution of an assessment district pursuant to the terms and provisions of Section 15.01.065 of Chapter 15.01 of the Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC"), which assessment district is known and designated as, "LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1 - ZONE 2" (hereinafter the "Assessment District"); and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the Assessment District, without extensive capital improvements at a significant cost, does not provide the adjacent business or the general public with much if any benefit; and,

WHEREAS, the installation of capital improvements to the Assessment District would require a significantly higher assessment levy; and,

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined the property owners located within the Assessment District should no longer be levied an assessment for the maintenance of this area.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The City Council of the City of Culver City declares its intention to dissolve Zone 2 of the Assessment District and order the Zone 2 Fund Balance be refunded to the District property owners; and,

3. A public hearing is hereby set for August 23, 2010 at 7:00 p.m. in the City Hall Council Chambers, located at 9770 Culver Boulevard, Culver City, California 90232 during which public hearing the City Council shall receive public comment and, upon its conclusion, may determine to dissolve Zone 2 of the Assessment District.

**SUBJECT: LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1
FISCAL YEAR 2010-2011 ASSESSMENT ENGINEER'S REPORT**

LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE DISTRICT NO. 1 (hereinafter referred to as "District"), described herein, has been formed in accordance Chapter 15.01 of the Code of the City of Culver City, California.

Landscaping Maintenance District No. 1, consisting of certain public property and the real property within the District subject to assessment, is shown on maps consisting of two pages which have been filed in the Office of the City Clerk on May 21, 1979; April 21, 1980; April 12, 1982, and April 11, 1983; and by this reference are made a part hereof (pages 10 and 11).

Landscaping and Irrigation System Plans

The landscaping maintenance areas were constructed in several phases and improved with irrigation systems. The initial improvements for Zone 1 were constructed by a developer in accordance with approved plans under separate bonded agreement. The plans for the initial improvements for Zone 1 consist of landscaping plans, Drawing No. 5024-39g (one sheet) approved January 21, 1980, and landscape irrigation system plans, Drawing No. 4024-39g (two sheets) approved January 3, 1979. The plans for the initial improvements for Zone 2 consist of landscaping, planting and irrigation plans, Drawing No. 5024-39g (four sheets) approved May 3, 1978. The plans for the initial improvements of Annexation No. 1 to Zone 2 consist of landscaping plans, Drawing No. 5049-55g (sheet 16 of 19) approved April 1, 1982, and landscape irrigation system plans, Drawing no. 5049-55g (sheet 17 of 19 sheets) approved April 1, 1982.

Performance of Maintenance by City Forces and/or Contractor

The maintenance of the improvements is provided by City of Culver City forces and/or maintenance contractors through contracts awarded by the City, and the costs thereof shall be assessed to the benefiting properties within the District.

Parcel Assessments Based Upon Benefit Received

It is proposed to assess the total amount of maintenance and incidental costs for maintaining the landscaped areas to the individual parcels of real property within the District in proportion to the estimated benefit to be received by such parcels of real property. The assessments of such costs commenced upon acceptance of the improvements by the City of Culver City and the commencement of maintenance. This fiscal year assessment is calculated to be \$190.20 per lot for Zone 1 and \$.0213 per square foot of assessable land for Zone 2, based on the data shown in Tables I, II, III, IV, and V. The proposed individual assessments are shown on the attached

assessment roll.

Method of Assessment

The District is divided into two zones, Zone 1 and Zone 2. Zone 1 consists of all the lots in Tracts 34390, 34371, 36218, eight of the nine lots of Tract 33484, and thirty-one of the thirty-two lots of Tract 28805, all of which derive an equal benefit from the Zone 1 landscaping. Zone 2 consists of the Westside Business Park and eight other parcels of land adjoining Westside Business Park on the west. Each parcel in Zone 2 derives a benefit from the Zone 2 landscaping based upon the area of that parcel. The assessments will be spread in accordance with the following formula.

Zone 1 Annual Rate Per Parcel =

Estimated Cost of Maintenance and Administration for Zone 1

Divided by:

Number of Parcels in Zone 1

Zone 2 Annual Rate Per Parcel =

Estimated Cost of Maintenance and Administration for Zone 2

Multiplied by:

Square Footage of Each Parcel

Divided by:

Total Square Footage of All parcels in Zone 2

Estimated Cost of Maintenance and Improvements

The annual assessment amount for maintenance and improvements for each zone for the fiscal year is calculated using the following:

- A. The total cost of constructing or installing all proposed improvements and maintaining and servicing all existing and proposed improvements, including all incidental expenses.
- B. The amount of any surplus or deficit in the District Fund to be carried over from the previous fiscal year.
- C. The amount of any contributions to be made from sources other than assessments levied pursuant to District assessment proceedings.

- D. The amount, if any, of the annual installment for an assessment ordered by the City Council wherein the estimated cost of any improvements shall be levied and collected in annual installments.
- E. The net amount to be assessed upon assessable lands within the District shall be the total maintenance and improvement costs, as referred to in A., above, increased or decreased, as the case may be, by any of the amounts referred to in B., C., or D., above.
- F. Item B above may specify individual parcels within a zone that did not receive notice of or pay assessments levied by the City Council, and which assessments are carried over and added to the assessments for the current fiscal year for each such specified parcel.

Recommended Assessment:

Zone 1:

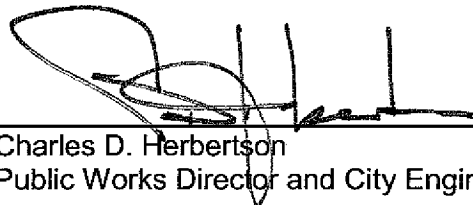
On July 13, 2009, the proposed assessment increase for Zone 1 was approved by a majority of the votes received from members of the District. Also, the members of the District approved an annual increase based on the February Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers for the Los Angeles – Riverside - Orange County area plus a 5% premium each year until the revenues generated from the District match the annual expenditures and the fund has a positive balance.

For Zone 1, staff is proposing the City Council approve that the assessment district levy be modified to provide for an annual increase based on the Consumer Price Index (CPI) plus an additional amount up to 5% as needed to provide sufficient revenues for the District. Based on the information provided by the Department of Labor, the CPI increase is 1.44%. Based on the review of the expenditures and revenues, it is recommended that the proposed total increase to the assessment levy be 2.80 (1.44% + 1.36%). The existing assessment levy per parcel is \$184.92. The proposed assessment levy will be \$190.20 per parcel for a total amount of \$34,236 (180 parcels) for Fiscal Year 2010-11.

Zone 2: Staff is proposing that the City Council disband Zone 2 and the remaining funds be refunded to the property owners for Fiscal Year 2010-2011. Therefore, the property owners in Zone 2 will not receive an assessment levy on their property tax bill for Fiscal Year 2010-2011. This maintenance area is separated from the adjacent property owners by a 7 foot high wall and has one entrance gate. The area does not appear to be accessed by the property owners for enjoyment. The area has not received any capital improvements in many years and is located within the Los Angeles County flood control area. In order to install capital improvements such as an enhanced entrance, new landscaping, decomposed granite pathways, lighting, security measures, and tables and benches, would require expenditures of over \$250,000.

The proposed assessment and individual assessments to the District are shown in EXHIBITS A and B, respectively.

DISTRICT BOUNDARY DESCRIPTIONS

Zone 1: The general location is the north central portion of the City of Culver City, California. Zone 1 of the Maintenance District includes the enclosed 51 parcels of Tract No. 34390, the enclosed 45 parcels of Tract No. 34371, the enclosed 45 parcels of Tract No. 36218, the enclosed 8 parcels of Tract No. 33484, and the enclosed 31 parcels of Tract No. 28805, for a total number of 180 parcels; surrounded on the southeast by Culver Boulevard; on the southwest by Elenda Street; on the northwest by Arizona Avenue and the most northerly line of Tract No. 34371 and Tract No. 28805; and on the northeast by the northeasterly line of Tract No. 28805; all as more specifically shown on the Diagram of Landscaping Maintenance District No. 1, on file in the office of the City Engineer, City of Culver City.

Zone 2: The general location is the central portion of the City. Zone 2 of the Maintenance District includes 9 parcels of land located on the northwesterly side of Jefferson Boulevard east of Overland Avenue' bounded by Jefferson Boulevard on the south; by Overland Avenue, Virginia Avenue and Jordan Way on the southwest; by the Los Angeles County Flood Control District right-of-way for Ballona Creek on the north; and by the northeasterly line of Westside Business Park on the northeast. Maintenance will be performed on the southeasterly twenty-foot section of said Los Angeles County Flood Control District right-of-way, all as more specifically shown on the Diagram of Landscaping Maintenance District No. 1, Zone 2, on file in the Office of the City Engineer, City of Culver City.
