

1 2. The measures voted upon at the election are as follows:

2 **Measure C:** “**Culver City Neighborhood Safety and City Services**
3 **Protection Measure.** Shall the measure to maintain 911 emergency response times by
4 retaining firefighters, police officers, paramedics; fully staff neighborhood fire stations; fix
5 potholes/streets; maintain senior services, after school programs, parks and other general
6 fund City services, by increasing Culver City's sales tax one-quarter cent, until ended by
7 voters with no rate increase, generating approximately \$4,900,000 annually, requiring
8 independent annual audits, and all funds used locally, be adopted?”

9 **Measure D:** “Shall the measure amending Sections 606 and 1500 of
10 the Culver City Charter to change the date of the City's General Municipal Election for City
11 Council Members from April of even-numbered years to the date of the statewide general
12 election, currently held in November of even-numbered years, effective in 2020, in
13 accordance with the California Voter Participation Rights Act be adopted?”

15 3. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes
16 given in the City to the Measures above named are listed in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and
17 made a part hereof.

18 4. As a result of the election, a majority of voters voting on Measure C
19 voted in favor of it and the Measure was carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

20 5. As a result of the election, a majority of voters voting on Measure D
21 voted in favor of it and the Measure was carried and shall be deemed adopted and ratified.

22 6. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City
23 of Culver City a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) the whole number of
24 ballots cast in the City; (2) the Measures voted upon; (3) the number of votes given at each
25 precinct for and against each of the Measures; and (4) the total number of votes for and
26 against each of the Measures.
