

## City of Culver City Commissions and Committees

Committee	Description
Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee	Provides input and participates in planning for City bicycle and pedestrian projects.
Civil Services Commission	Advises on all matters concerning the civil service system and recommends adoption of amendments to the Civil Service Rules.
Advisory Committee on Housing and Homelessness	Advises on identifying short-and-long-term strategies for decreasing homelessness; reviews services being provided by independent contractors; and makes recommendations for improving service delivery.
Cultural Affairs Commission	Advises on matters pertaining to community enrichment through the arts, arts education, historic preservation, and cultural issues; advocates for equity, diversity, and inclusion in City cultural activities and programs; implements City's Public Art Program; and encourages integration of cultural affairs into social and economic fabric of the City.
Equity & Human Relations Advisory Committee	Recommends programs, policies, and activities that promote positive human relations and equitable outcomes and opportunities in all aspects of community life.
Finance Advisory Committee	Advises based on specific tasks/duties approved by Council, such as reviews of the revenues and expenditures of Measure funds consistent with the City's Adopted Budget; methods for the City to reduce expenditures; and methods to increase or diversify City revenues.
General Plan Advisory Committee	Supports equitable and meaningful public participation in the General Plan Update process by providing the community's perspective on policies and programs proposed for the updated Plan.
Parks, Recreation and Community Services Commission	Advises on matters pertaining to public recreation, parks, recreation/community center facilities, open space and tree programs, and music/entertainment performed in City parks.
Planning Commission	Makes recommendations regarding the General Plan and the physical development of the City, among other things. Has authority over zoning, land subdivisions, and building as granted by Council and State law.
