3 Exhibit "A" to this Resolution and will replace the existing Council Policy Statement 2301.
4 The amended Policy, as set forth in Exhibit A, shall supersede all other previously adopted
5 policies regarding the subject matter therein.

6 2. The City Manager is hereby authorized to establish rules, regulations and
7 procedures pertaining to the rental and use of the Veterans' Memorial Rental Complex
8 Facilities through an Administrative or Departmental Policy.

9 3. The City Manager is hereby authorized to format the attached City Council
10 Policy in a format consistent with other City Council adopted policies and shall include the
11 final version of this adopted Policy with other adopted policies.

12 4. The City Manager shall distribute the attached City Council Policy to
13 interested parties, which include, but are not limited to, City Staff.

PURPOSE:

To establish policies regarding the use of the Veterans Memorial Complex Rental Facilities ("VMC Facilities").

STATEMENT OF POLICY:

It is the intent of the City Council to provide quality public facilities that are accessible and available for diverse recreational activities and to ensure community members, businesses and organizations have a safe and enjoyable environment for public and private events.

VMC Facilities shall be rented on a first come, first served basis. Rules, regulations and procedures pertaining to the rental and use of the VMC Facilities, which are not inconsistent with this Policy, shall be established by the City Manager or his/her designee.

PROHIBITED USES AND ACTIVITIES IN VMC FACILITIES:

The following is a non-exhaustive list of uses, activities and items that are prohibited in the VMC Facilities:

- Smoking of tobacco and marijuana products;
- Use of electronic smoking devices (vaping);
- Illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia;
- Guns, weapons or weapon exhibitions;
- Pyrotechnics or any fire presentation unless permitted by the Culver City Fire Department;
- Live non-service animals, reptiles, birds, insects, fish or other sea creatures;
- Illegal gambling;
- Adult film production;
- Massage and exotic dancing;

- Nudity and partial nudity, unless permitted by the Committee on Permits and Licenses (i.e. bodybuilding);
 - Other uses, activities or items that are unlawful in accordance with local, state or federal law; and
 - Other uses activities or items that are deemed contrary to the public health, safety or welfare, as determined by the City Manager or designee.
