Dan Hernandez, Parks Recreation and Community Services Director, discussed the 5K Fun Run held the previous weekend and attendance at Spring Break camp; he reported that the Syd Kronenthal Playground project and upgrades to the sound system at the Senior Center were approved for solicitation of bids at the last City Council meeting; he announced that the recent audit of the Prop A grant that funded the construction of the Culver City Park Playground went well, with no findings against the City; he thanked the Culver City Senior Citizens Association for their help in funding the Senior Center's Patio upgrade; and he announced that the Senior Citizens Association had received the Champions of the Community Award at the California Parks and Recreation Society conference and awards dinner in March.
