3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, (1) APPROVING AN AMENDED
5 ASSESSMENT ENGINEER'S REPORT; (2) DECLARING ITS
6 INTENTION TO LEVY AND COLLECT THE REFUSE,
7 RECYCLING AND ORGANICS COLLECTION FEES; AND (3)
8 SETTING A TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING
9 THEREON.

10 WHEREAS, Section 5.01.070 of the Culver City Municipal Code authorizes
11 the City Council to establish, by resolution, refuse collection fees; and

12 WHEREAS, these proceedings relate to the levy and collection of refuse
13 collection fees effective July 1, 2017; and

14 WHEREAS, the fees for refuse collection were last increased in 2015, based
15 upon the Engineer's Report dated May 6, 2015 ("2015 Engineer's Report"), which reflects
16 increased fees over the next five (5) fiscal years; and

17 WHEREAS, an amendment to the 2015 Engineer's Report ("Amended
18 Engineer's Report") has been prepared in order to ascertain whether the current costs to
19 provide the City's refuse collection services are accurately reflected in the existing refuse
20 collection fees and whether an increase is warranted; and

21 WHEREAS, the Amended Engineer's Report has been filed with the City
22 Clerk and submitted to the City Council; and

23 WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully examined and reviewed the
24 Amended Engineer's Report as presented and is preliminary satisfied with the proposed
25 report, each and all of the budget items and documents as set forth therein and is satisfied
26 that the levy amounts, on a preliminary basis, have been allocated so that the proposed
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1 fees accurately reflect the current costs to provide the City's refuse, recycling and organics
2 collection services, as set forth in the Amended Engineer's Report.

3 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES
4 HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

5 1. The Engineer's Report as presented, consisting of the following: the
6 estimated costs of operation, maintenance, repair and improvements for the provision of
7 refuse, recycling and organics collection services, and the formulas used to determine that
8 the proposed fees accurately reflect the current costs to provide such services, is hereby
9 approved on a preliminary basis and is on file in the Office of the City Clerk and open for
10 public inspection.

12 2. It is the intention of the City Council to levy and collect the proposed
13 fees to pay the costs and expenses for the operation, maintenance, repair and
14 improvements necessary to provide the City's refuse, recycling and organics collection
15 services, effective July 1, 2017. The operation, maintenance, repair and improvements are
16 generally described as: costs for refuse collection, disposal, recycling and organics
17 programs and public outreach, including repairs and maintenance to refuse vehicles and
18 repairs and maintenance and improvements to the transfer station. Costs include all
19 necessary service, operations, administration and maintenance required to provide the
20 City's refuse, recycling and organics collection services in a manner that serves the best
21 interest of the public health, safety and general welfare.
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23 3. The Amended Engineer's Report, as preliminarily approved by the City
24 Council, is on file with the City Clerk and open for public inspection. Reference is made to
25 the Amended Engineer's Report for a full detailed description of the proposed fees
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1 necessary to accurately reflect the City's costs to operate the refuse and recycling
2 operations.

3 4. As recommended in the Refuse Rate Study: 1) the maximum
4 assessment for residential service would increase by 7%; 2) the maximum assessment for
5 commercial service would increase on average by 7%; and 3) the maximum assessment
6 for drop box service would increase on average by 7%. The Refuse Rate Study further
7 recommends assessment increases of various amounts for other miscellaneous fees, as
8 set forth in the Engineer's Report.
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10 5. Notice is hereby given that a public hearing is scheduled to be held at
11 the Mike Balkman Council Chambers, 9770 Culver Boulevard, Culver City, California, on
12 July 24, 2017 at 7:00pm or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard. All interested
13 persons, prior to the conclusion of the hearing, shall be afforded the opportunity to hear
14 and be heard. The City Council shall consider all oral statements or written communication
15 made or filed by any interested person.
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17 6. The City Clerk is hereby directed to give notice of the public hearing by
18 causing the resolution of intention, or summary thereof, to be published at least 45 days
19 prior to the date set for public hearing as provided under applicable law.
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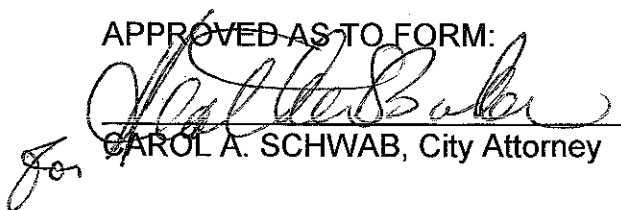
