AGENDA ITEM : Adoption of a Resolution of the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, Reciting the Fact of the General Municipal Election Held on April 10, 2012 and Stating the Results of Such Election in Accordance with the City Charter.

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WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Culver City, California, on Tuesday, April 10, 2012, as required by the Charter of the City of Culver City; and,

WHEREAS, the City Clerk, acting in the capacity of Elections Official as provided for in the Charter of the City of Culver City, canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, which results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as Exhibits "A" and "B."

1. The whole number of ballots cast in the precincts except vote by mail ballot and provisional ballots is 2,190. The whole number of vote by mail voter ballots and the whole number of provisional ballots cast in the City is 2,699, making a total of 4,889 ballots cast in the City.

1 2. The names of persons voted for at the election for Member of the City
2 Council are as follows: Scott Malsin, Stephen Murray, Micheál (Mehaul) O'Leary, Andrew
3 N. Weissman, Jim B. Clarke, and Meghan Sahli-Wells. Further, the voters considered
4 Measure X, a proposal to increase the City's transient occupancy tax from 12% to 14%.

5 3. The number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes
6 given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective office for which the
7 persons were candidates and for and against Measure X are as listed in Exhibit "A"
8 attached hereto and made a part hereof.

9 4. The City Council does declare and determine that Andrew N.
10 Weissman, Meghan Sahli-Wells, and Micheál (Mehaul) O'Leary are elected as a Member
11 of the City Council for the full term of four years; and Jim B. Clarke is elected as Member of
12 the City Council for the unexpired term of approximately two years. Further, more than a
13 majority of those votes cast being in favor of Measure X, the City Council does declare and
14 determine that said Measure X is PASSED and the Mayor of Culver City is hereby
15 authorized to execute the Ordinance enacting said Measure X.

16 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City
17 of Culver City a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) the whole number of
18 ballots cast in the City; (2) the names of the persons voted for; (3) the office into which
19 each person was voted; (4) the number of votes given at each precinct to each person; (5)
20 the total number of votes given to each person; and (6) the total number of votes cast for
21 and against Measure X.

22 6. The City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the
23 persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated.
24 The City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in
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1 the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in
2 the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted
3 into the respective office to which they have been elected.

4 7. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this
5 resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

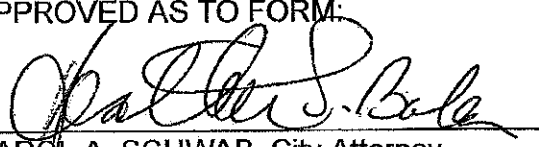
