



1 Development Program are as follows:

2 A. To stabilize and preserve existing residential neighborhoods,  
3 prevent and eliminate blight by improving supportive public facilities and  
4 constructing streetscape improvements, and comply with the federal Americans  
5 with Disabilities Act (ADA).

6 B. To provide funding for projects serving the elderly, the disabled  
7 and youth, which includes the City position of Disability Services Specialist.

8 3. The projects and dollar amounts in order of priority for 2019-2020,  
9 attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, are hereby approved  
10 and adopted and shall serve as the basis for filing the application for Federal Assistance.

11 4. The filing of an application for Federal Assistance under the Community  
12 Development Block Grant program for 2019-2020 as part of the Los Angeles Urban County,  
13 including Program Certifications, is hereby authorized.

14 5. The City Manager of the City of Culver City or his/her designee is hereby  
15 designated and directed as the authorized representative of the City of Culver City to act in  
16 connection with the application, to execute documents relating to the application, and to  
17 provide such additional information as may be required.

18 6. Resolution No. 2018-R103 is hereby rescinded.
