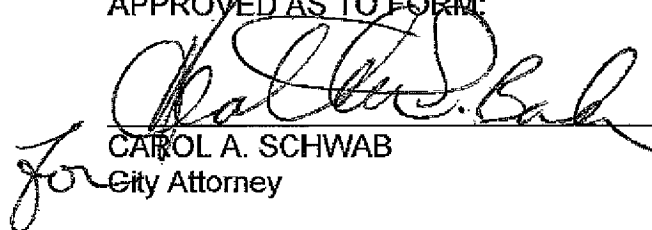

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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, FIXING THE EMPLOYER'S
5 CONTRIBUTION UNDER THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES'
6 MEDICAL AND HOSPITAL CARE ACT WITH RESPECT TO
7 THE CULVER CITY FIREFIGHTERS GROUP AND
8 RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2006-R080.

9 WHEREAS, Government Code Section 22892(a) provides that a local
10 agency contracting under the Public Employees' Medical and Hospital Care Act (the
11 "Act") shall fix the amount of the employer's contribution at an amount not less than the
12 amount required under Section 22892(b)(1) of the Act; and

13 WHEREAS, the City of Culver City (the "Employer") is a local agency
14 contracting under the Act for participation by members of the Culver City Firefighters
15 Group.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
17 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

18 1. The Employer's contribution for each employee or annuitant shall
19 be the amount necessary to pay the full cost of his/her enrollment, including the
20 enrollment of his/her family members, in a health benefits plan up to a maximum of
21 \$112 per month, plus administrative fees and Contingency Reserve Fund Assessments;
22 and

23 2. The City of Culver City and the Culver City Firefighters Group have
24 fully complied with any and all applicable provisions of Government Code Section 7507
25 in electing the benefits set forth above.

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3. Resolution No. 2006-R080 is hereby rescinded.
