2 Exhibits A through J, attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference.

4 J, shall be effective on July 1, 2011.

5 SECTION 3. The Fees and Charges set forth in Exhibits D, E and H shall be
6 effective on July 16, 2012.

7 SECTION 4. The fees for Emergency Ambulance Transport Fees in Exhibit E
8 are adjusted annually in accordance with the fee schedule approved by the Los Angeles
9 County General Public Allowable Rate Schedule.

10 SECTION 5. The City Manager, or his or her designee, in his or her
11 discretion, may waive the fees established in this Resolution for any municipal, county,
12 state and/or federal government agency.

13 SECTION 6. If any portion of this Resolution or any Exhibits attached hereto
14 is held invalid, the remainder of this Resolution and the Exhibits attached hereto shall not
15 be affected.

16 SECTION 7. The City Council instructs the Finance Department to earmark
17 4.5% of the actual user fees received in Fiscal Year 2012-13 from the Building & Safety
18 Division, Engineering Division, Planning Division, Police Department, and Fire Department
19 to fund the City's Other Post Employment Benefits liability.

20 SECTION 8. Resolution number 2011-R027 is hereby rescinded in its
21 entirety.

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1 SECTION 9. Exhibit B of Resolution 2000-R074, which established the
2 Urban Stormwater Mitigation and Construction Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan
3 Check fees, is hereby rescinded, as those fees are incorporated in this Resolution.
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5 SECTION 10. Exhibit A of Resolution No. 2003-R020, which established
6 various fees for the Veterans Memorial Complex, is hereby rescinded, as those fees are
7 incorporated in this Resolution.
