2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF ENERGY
4 UPGRADE CALIFORNIA, AN INITIATIVE TO EMPOWER
CALIFORNIANS TO BECOME ENERGY STEWARDS.

5 WHEREAS, California, the Golden State, is a national leader in energy
6 conservation, embracing its residents' and small businesses' efforts to support clean
7 energy and energy efficiency goals; and

8 WHEREAS, these efforts have put California on track to double energy
9 efficiency, produce 33% of its energy from renewable resources, and reduce greenhouse
10 gas emissions by 40% before 2030, which are goals set forth in the "Clean Energy and
11 Pollution Reduction Act of 2015" (Senate Bill 350);

12 WHEREAS, all Californians have the opportunity to practice energy-
13 conscious and environmentally friendly actions that have energy-saving impacts.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
15 HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

16 1. Culver City supports Energy Upgrade California® ("EUC"), a statewide
17 initiative committed to empowering Californians to become energy stewards by integrating
18 energy management practices into their daily lives, and EUC's call to all California
19 residents and businesses to preserve California's pristine environment by practicing
20 energy-conscious and environmentally friendly actions that have energy-saving impacts to
21 help "Keep it Golden."

22 2. The City Council hereby encourages each Culver City resident to take
23 one energy-saving action every day to use less energy (i.e. flipping off lights when not in
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1 use, washing clothing on the cold cycle, lowering the thermostat, etc.). Each individual
2 action can result in a big impact not only for Culver City, but also the state of California.

3 3. The City Council urges all Culver City residents and small businesses
4 to become more conscious energy stewards, recognizing that we all have the power to
5 make a significant impact in helping California "Keep it Golden" by taking even small
6 actions every day.
