Saturday, November 14, 6-9pm

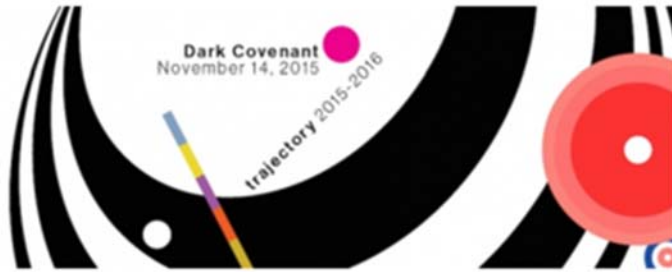
