

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING A 4% ADMINISTRATIVE FEE FOR ACTIVITY REGISTRATION AND FACILITY RESERVATION PROCESSING, TO BE INCLUDED IN THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT'S CURRENT RECREATION USER FEES SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, there is no administrative fee for activity registration and facility reservation processing in the Parks Recreation and Community Services Department's (PRCS) current Recreation User Fees schedule; and

WHEREAS, the costs to process registrations/reservations through ActiveNet, the City's vendor for online processing, has increased annually as registrations/reservations have increased to more than \$140,000 annually (ActiveNet's processing fees are based on a percentage of the registration/reservation fee charged); and

WHEREAS, imposing an administrative fee will help the City recover a portion of the costs it takes to process activity registrations and facility reservations (excluding staff time or any other overhead costs), while keeping the costs to the community to participate in activities and rent facilities low, and spreading out the costs equally across all registrations and reservations; and

WHEREAS, the proposed 4% administrative fee would be applied to the base rate of the registration/reservation fee and allow most of the ActiveNet's processing fees to be recovered since it would be applied to all registrations/reservations regardless of the nature of the transaction (i.e., in person or online); and

WHEREAS. in FΥ 18-19, less than 12% of PRCS the registrations/reservations were paid online. In this COVID-19-era, it is highly desirable to increase online transactions and decrease potential exposure through in-person transactions. By eliminating the current and higher (5.41%) fee for the online customers and replacing it with a lower (4%) administrative fee across all transactions, it is the City's goal to increase online transactions, which will save those online customers money and decrease in-person contact; and

WHEREAS, on June 22, 2020, at a duly noticed public meeting, the City Council considered establishment of the proposed 4% administrative fee for PRCS Department activity registration and facility reservation processing; and

WHEREAS, after giving the public an opportunity to be heard and considering all information before it, the City Council approved the establishment of the proposed fee, as set forth in this Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the fee established herein are based upon the reasonable cost of providing the services for processing PRCS Department activity registration and facility reservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:
