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RESOLUTION NO 2005-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING CERTAIN COUNCIL MEMBERS TO SUBMIT ARGUMENTS REGARDING A MEASURE TO REVISE THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA WHICH WILL BE ON THE BALLOT FOR THE APRIL 11, 2006, MUNICIPAL ELECTION AND DIRECTING IMPARTIAL ANALYSIS OF THE MEASURE BY THE CITY ATTORNEY

2 Amendments may be submitted to the City Clerk

3 3 That the City Council directs the City Clerk to transmit a copy of the
4 measure to the City Attorney The City Attorney shall prepare an impartial analysis of
5 the measure and file it with the City Clerk at a time mutually agreed to by the City Clerk
6 and the City Attorney but in any event no later than the deadline for submitting ballot
7 arguments

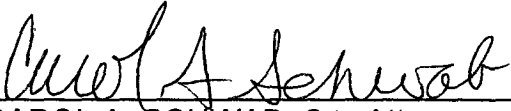
