

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-R

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANY ACTIONS NECESSARY FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED BY THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY (OHS) UNDER THE PROPOSITION 1B TRANSIT SECURITY PROGRAM/CALIFORNIA TRANSIT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Highway Safety, Traffic Reduction, Air Quality, and Port Security Bond Act of 2006, approved by the voters as California State Proposition 1B on November, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Governor's Office of Homeland Security (OHS) is the State Administrative Agency (SSA) for the California Transit Security Grant Program funded under Proposition 1B with general obligation bonds for transit system safety, security, and disaster response project; and

WHEREAS, the State Controller of California identified the City of Culver City as an eligible transit operator; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has or will provide all assurances to the Governor's Office of Homeland Security required for the project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEAREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. Approves the filing of grant applications to the OHS as funding opportunities become available from the Proposition 1B Transit Security Program/California Transit Security Grant Program; and

1 2. Appoints the City Manager, or designee, as authorizing agent to
2 execute any actions necessary of the purpose of obtaining financial assistance provided by
3 the OHS under the Proposition 1B Transit Security Grant/California Transit Security Grant
4 Program.
