AGENDA ITEM: Adopt Resolution 2008-R Establishing a Preferential Parking District (Linwood Howe Residential Parking District) encompassing the area of Van Buren Place from La Ballona Creek to A Street; Irving Place from Lucerne Avenue to A Street, La Fayette Place from Lucerne Avenue to Culver Boulevard; Duquesne Avenue from La Ballona Creek to Culver Boulevard; Braddock Drive from Duquesne Avenue to Irving Place; Farragut Drive from La Fayette Place to Van Buren Place; Ince Boulevard from La Ballona Creek to Washington Boulevard; and Lucerne Avenue from Duquesne Avenue to Ince Boulevard, only adjacent to residential-zoned lots, with no parking except with permit from Friday, 6 PM to Sunday, 12 AM, and 1 hour time-limited parking, permit exempted, from Sunday 12:00 a.m. to Friday 6:00 p.m.

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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING CERTAIN STREETS AS PREFERENTIAL PARKING ZONES AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2007-R011.

WHEREAS, Resolution 2004-R085, adopted on November 22, 2004, adopted procedures and regulations for establishing preferential parking zones and designated certain streets as preferential parking zones; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer recommends to the City Council that a Preferential Parking District known as the Linwood Howe Residential Parking District, comprised only of the residential frontages of Van Buren Place from La Ballona Creek to School Street; Irving Place from Lucerne Avenue to School Street, La Fayette Place from Lucerne Avenue to Culver Boulevard; Duquesne Avenue from La Ballona Creek to Culver Boulevard; Braddock Drive from Duquesne Avenue to Irving Place; Farragut Drive from La Fayette Place to Van Buren Place; Ince Boulevard from La Ballona Creek to Washington Boulevard; and Lucerne Avenue from Duquesne Avenue to Ince Boulevard, be designated as a preferential parking streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has evaluated the recommendation pursuant to the rules and procedures adopted by Resolution No. 2004-085 in Exhibit "A" and concurs that the above designations are necessary to limit excessive intrusion of non-residential parking into a residential neighborhood where such parking practices have negatively impacted the residential neighborhood; and

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby approves the recommendation of the City Engineer and designates the residential frontages of the streets in the Linwood Howe Residential Parking District as resident-only parking with a permit from Friday, 6:00 p.m. to

1 Sunday, 12:00 a.m., and time-limited 1-hour parking from Sunday, 12:00 a.m. to Friday,
2 6:00 p.m., except with a permit; and

3 WHEREAS, the current List of Zones and Corresponding Parking Restrictions
4 attached as Exhibit "B" to Resolution No. 2004-085 must be amended to reflect the
5 addition of the Linwood Howe Residential Parking District as preferential parking streets;

6 NOW, THEREFORE the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY
7 RESOLVE as follows:

9 1. Procedures and Regulations for Preferential Parking Zones:

10 Pursuant to Vehicle Code Section 22507 and Culver City Municipal Code Section
11 7.03.300, the Procedures and Regulations for Preferential Parking Zones, attached
12 hereto as Exhibit "A", are hereby approved and adopted. The Engineering Division shall
13 have authority to promulgate and administer procedures and regulations implementing
14 preferential parking zones, the issuance of preferential parking permits and the collection
15 of fees for these permits.

17 2. Preferential Parking Zones Established: Pursuant to Vehicle Code
18 Section 22507 and Culver City Municipal Code Section 7.03.300, the streets identified in
19 Exhibit "B," attached hereto, are established as preferential parking zones and
20 preferential parking shall be permitted on said streets in accordance with the regulations
21 set forth therein.

23 3. Signs: Signs shall be posted within any preferential parking
24 zone giving notice of all preferential parking restrictions.

25 4. Preferential Parking Privilege: Within a preferential parking zone,
26 the following are exempt from any posted "Time-Limited Parking Except By Permit" or "No
27 Parking Anytime Except By Permit" parking restrictions:

1 a. A vehicle with a valid preferential parking permit, issued for
2 use in the zone in which the vehicle is parked and displayed in accordance
3 with the instructions issued with said preferential parking permit;

4 b. A vehicle displaying an authorized disabled person's
5 placard issued pursuant to Vehicle Code Sections 22511.55 or 22511.59; or,

6 c. A vehicle displaying an authorized disabled person's
7 identification license plate issued pursuant to Vehicle Code Section
8 5007.
9

10 5. Limitation on Preferential Parking Privilege: Notwithstanding the
11 preferential parking privilege created in Section 4, above, a vehicle with a preferential
12 parking permit shall comply with all other governing parking restrictions,
13 regulations or laws including, but not limited to, restrictions applicable to street
14 sweeping activities.

16 6. Resolution No. 2007-R011 is hereby rescinded.

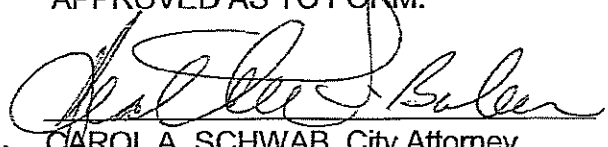
