RESOLUTION NO. 2009-R_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING THE LOS ANGELES COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH AS THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ENFORCEMENT AGENCY WITHIN THE CITY OF CULVER CITY AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. CS-7570.

WHEREAS, the Z'berg-Kapiloff Solid Waste Control Act of 1976 (the "Act") requires that there shall be designated in each county an enforcement agency to carry out the provisions of the Act; and

WHEREAS, on October 24, 1977, the City Council, by Resolution No. CS-7570, designated the Los Angeles County Department of Health Services ("DHS") as the agency to undertake the enforcement of the Act, as a complement to other health services which the County provides for the City; and

WHEREAS, in July of 2006, DHS reorganized and the Los Angeles County Department of Public Health ("DPH") was formed; and

WHEREAS, within DPH is the Los Angeles County Department of Environmental Health, Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP) Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), which is currently authorized and designated under DHS to enforce all laws and regulations relating to solid waste disposal, handling and transport within the Culver City jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The Los Angeles County Department of Public Health, Environmental Health, Solid Waste Management Program is hereby designated as the Local Enforcement Agency (LEA), pursuant to California Government Code Section 66795, to enforce all laws and regulations relating to solid waste disposal, handling and transport within the Culver City jurisdiction.

4 3. Resolution No. CS-7570 is hereby rescinded.
