5. **LECTURE/LIMITED TIME PERFORMANCE**
A Ratification of the approval for permit given on December 17, 2008 by the Assistant City Manager and Treasury Division Manager, pursuant to C.C.M.C. Section 11.01.515, to Victor Urena, Facilities Manager of **ED HARDY**, to conduct an Ed Hardy Corporate Holiday Party for all of its employees, to be held outdoors, with a tent, valet parking, caterers, live music, dancing, alcohol served at no charge, at the commercial location known as Smashbox Studios – 8549 Higuera St., on Friday, December 19, 2008 (set up), from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., Saturday, December 20, 2008 (event), from 7:30 p.m. to 12:00 a.m., and Sunday, December 21, 2008 (break down) from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m., *provided that* all terms and conditions set forth by the Culver City Police Department, Engineering Division, Planning Division, and Fire Prevention Bureau, are met and adhered to at all times. Previous permits have been issued.
