RESOLUTION NO. 2024-P001

A RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA RECOMMENDING TO THE CITY COUNCIL DENIAL OF A CITY-INITIATED ZONING CODE AMENDMENT P2024-0083-ZCA, AMENDING SECTIONS: 17.330.015 – DEFINITIONS, 17.330.040 – SIGNS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND 17.700.010 – DEFINITIONS OF SPECIALIZED TERMS AND PHRASES, OF THE CULVER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE (CCMC), TITLE 17–ZONING CODE AS IT RELATES TO DIGITAL WAYFINDING KIOSKS ON PUBLIC PROPERTY.

(Zoning Code Amendment, P2024-0083-ZCA)

WHEREAS, on April 24, 2024, after conducting a duly noticed public hearing on a City-initiated Zoning Code Amendment (P2024-0083-ZCA) amending Sections: 17.330.015 – Definitions, 17.330.040 – Signs in the Public Right-Of-Way, and 17.700.010 – Definitions of Specialized Terms and Phrases, of the Culver City Municipal Code (CCMC), Title 17–Zoning Code as it relates to digital wayfinding kiosks on public property, fully considering all reports, studies, environmental information, and testimony presented, the Planning Commission, by a vote of 3 to 2, recommended to the City Council denial of Zoning Code Amendment, P2024-0083-ZCA.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Planning Commission of the City of Culver City, California, does hereby resolve, as follows:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the foregoing recitations and the provisions of the CCMC, the following required findings for an amendment to the Zoning Code, as outlined in CCMC Section 17.620.030.A, cannot be made:

1. The proposed amendment ensures and maintains internal consistency with the goals, policies and strategies of all elements of the General Plan, and, in the case of a Zoning Code Amendment, will not create any inconsistencies with this Title.

The proposed Zoning Code Amendments are intended to allow the City to install digital wayfinding kiosks on public property that include commercial advertising. This finding

cannot be made because these amendments are inconsistent the following goals, objectives, and policies of the General Plan: Land Use Objective 22 Encourage 1 reinvestment in Downtown area to improve the area's economic vitality, visual quality and 2 pedestrian environment. 3 2. The proposed amendment would not be detrimental to the public interest, health, 4 safety, convenience or welfare of the City. 5 This finding cannot be made because the proposed amendment is detrimental to the public interest, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City due to the unknown 6 impacts related to the kiosks, including the unknown number of kiosks and the unknown 7 specific location of the kiosks. 8 9 SECTION 2.
