

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, STATE OF CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING AN ALL-MAIL BALLOT ELECTION FOR AUGUST 26, 2025

WHEREAS, the City of Culver City (the “City”) is experiencing a fiscal emergency; and

WHEREAS, at the March 4, 2025, City Council Meeting, the City Council unanimously requested that staff agendize a discussion item regarding the placement of a 0.25% sales tax increase ballot measure at an upcoming election; and

WHEREAS, the first available date for an all-mail ballot election is August 26, 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized to conduct all mail ballot elections pursuant to City Charter section 1505.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1: The City Council authorizes the conduct of an all-mail election dated August 26, 2025.

SECTION 2: The City Council hereby declares that, if any provision, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this Ordinance is rendered or declared invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council would have independently adopted the remaining provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases, or words of this Ordinance, and as such they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3: Pursuant to Section 619 of the City Charter, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption. Pursuant to Section 616 and 621 of the City Charter, prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the adoption, the City

2 News and shall post this Ordinance or a summary thereof in at least three (3) places
3 within the City.
