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3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
4 CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, CALLING FOR THE HOLDING OF
5 A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
6 TUESDAY, APRIL 12, 2016 FOR THE ELECTION OF CERTAIN
7 OFFICERS AS REQUIRED BY THE CITY CHARTER OF THE
8 CITY OF CULVER CITY

9 WHEREAS, Section 1500 of the City Charter of the City of Culver City
10 provides General Municipal Elections for the filling of all elective offices, other than the
11 Board of Education, shall be held in the City on the second Tuesday in April in each
12 even numbered year; and,

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to the applicable provisions of the City Charter and
14 State Law, at the 2016 General Municipal Election, the electors of the City shall choose
15 three Council Members each for the full term of office of four years commencing at the
16 meeting at which the election results are certified, and continuing until a successor is
17 elected and certified.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CULVER
19 CITY, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS
20 FOLLOWS:

21 SECTION 1. That pursuant to the requirements of the City Charter
22 related to General Municipal Elections, there is called and ordered to be held in
23 the City of Culver City, California, on Tuesday, April 12, 2016, a General
24 Municipal Election for the purposes of electing three (3) Members of the City
25 Council for the full term of four (4) years.

26 SECTION 2. That the ballots to be used at the election shall be in
27 form and content as required by law.

1 SECTION 3. That the City Clerk, as the City Elections Official as
2 designated in Section 1502 of the City Charter, is authorized to procure and
3 furnish any and all official ballots, notices, printed matter and all supplies,
4 equipment, and paraphernalia that may be necessary in order to properly and
5 lawfully conduct the election.

6 SECTION 4. That the polls for the election shall be open at seven
7 o'clock a.m. (7:00 A.M.) of the day of the election and shall remain open
8 continuously from that time until eight o'clock p.m. (8:00 P.M.) of the same day
9 when the polls shall be closed, pursuant to Elections Code Section 10242, except
10 as provided in Section 14401 of the Elections Code of the State of California.

11 SECTION 5. Pursuant to Elections Code Section 12310, a stipend
12 for services for the persons named as precinct board members is hereby fixed at
13 the sum of one hundred seventy five dollars (\$175.00) for each inspector and
14 one hundred five dollars (\$105.00) for each clerk for the election. In addition, the
15 sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) will be given to each precinct board member
16 to attend a training class. The rental of each polling place shall be the sum of
17 twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the election. When required, the compensation of
18 the custodian of a building shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) for the election.

19 SECTION 6. That in all particulars not recited in this resolution, the
20 election shall be held and conducted as provided by law for holding General
21 Municipal Elections.

22 SECTION 7. That notice of the time and place of holding the
23 election is hereby given and the City Clerk, pursuant to the City Charter, is
24 authorized to give further or additional notice of the election, in time, form and
25 manner as required by law.

26 SECTION 8. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and
27 adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.
