WEST HOLLYWOOD



City of West Hollywood
California 1984



- 60 Minute per block
- 4 hour return restriction
- 200 foot buffer from restaurants
- Event permits required for park access

BEVERLY HILLS



- No general park vending
- Primarily limited to City-Sanctioned events
- Vendor selection process
- Strict residential limits

SANTA MONICA



- Major exclusion zone near the Santa Monica Pier
- Restrictions around Palisades Park
- Strick dispoasable and food ware/enviromental rules

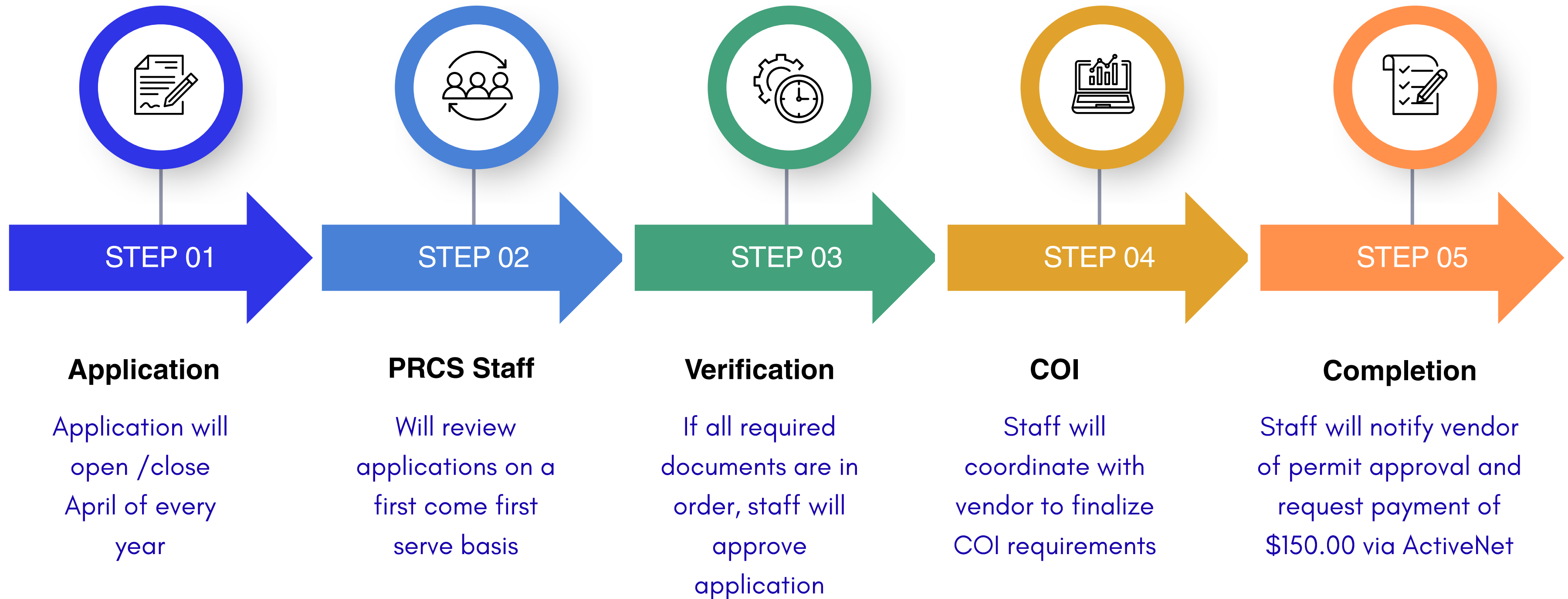

APPLICATION OVERVIEW



REQUIRED DOCUMENTS



- 1 Culver City Business License
- 2 Los Angeles County Department of Public Health Permit
- 3 Valid California Department of Tax and Fee Administrations Seller's Permit (CDTFA)
- 4 Signed Terms and Conditions Acknowledgment form
- 5 Certificate of Insurance

OPERATING TIMES



Food trucks are only allowed to operate:

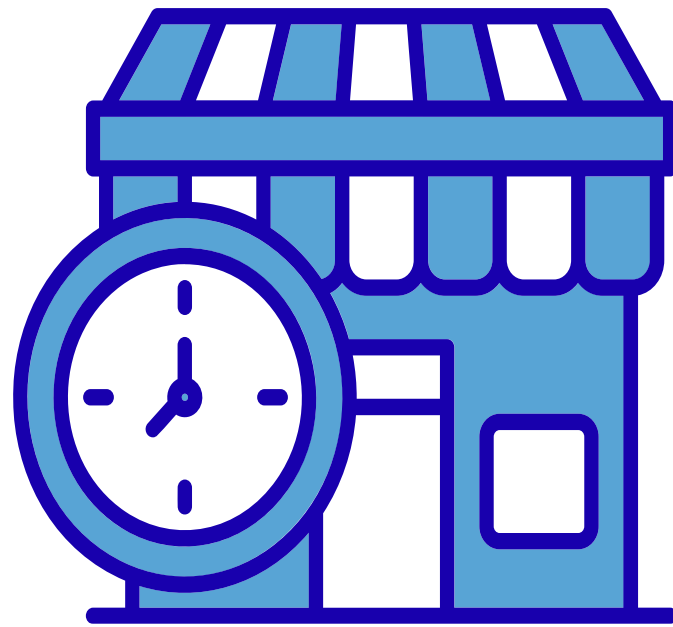
- Monday – Friday 3:00pm – 7:00pm
- Saturday – Sunday from 11:00am – 7:00pm
- No permits will be issued on City closed holidays
- No more than two (2) food trucks at any given park at the same time

OPERATING TIMES



- Food trucks are only allowed to be at one (1) park per week
 - Twice per week*
- Food trucks can't exceed four (4) parks in one month
- Food trucks can't exceed eight (8) vending engagements near parks per month
- Permits are issued for 4-hour increments

OPERATING TIMES



- Park access is restricted, vendors will not be able to set up chairs, tables, tents, etc., on park grounds unless:
 - A field permit is obtained prior to the vending occurrence
 - Depending on planned activity, a special event permit may be required

FOOD TRUCK DIMENSIONS

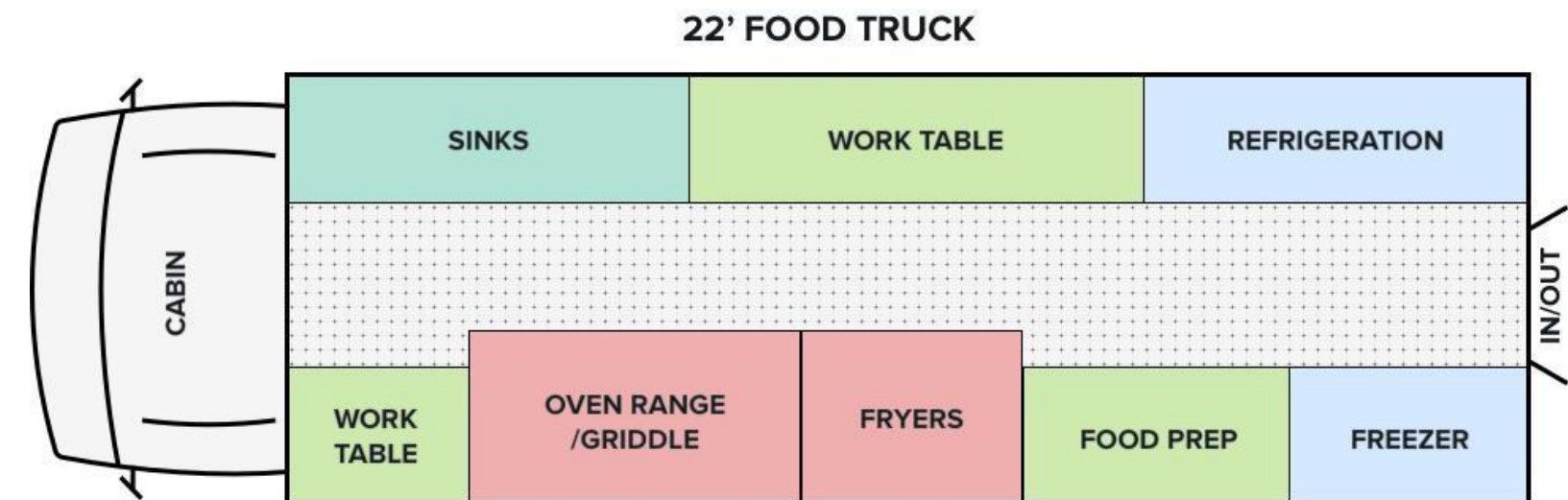
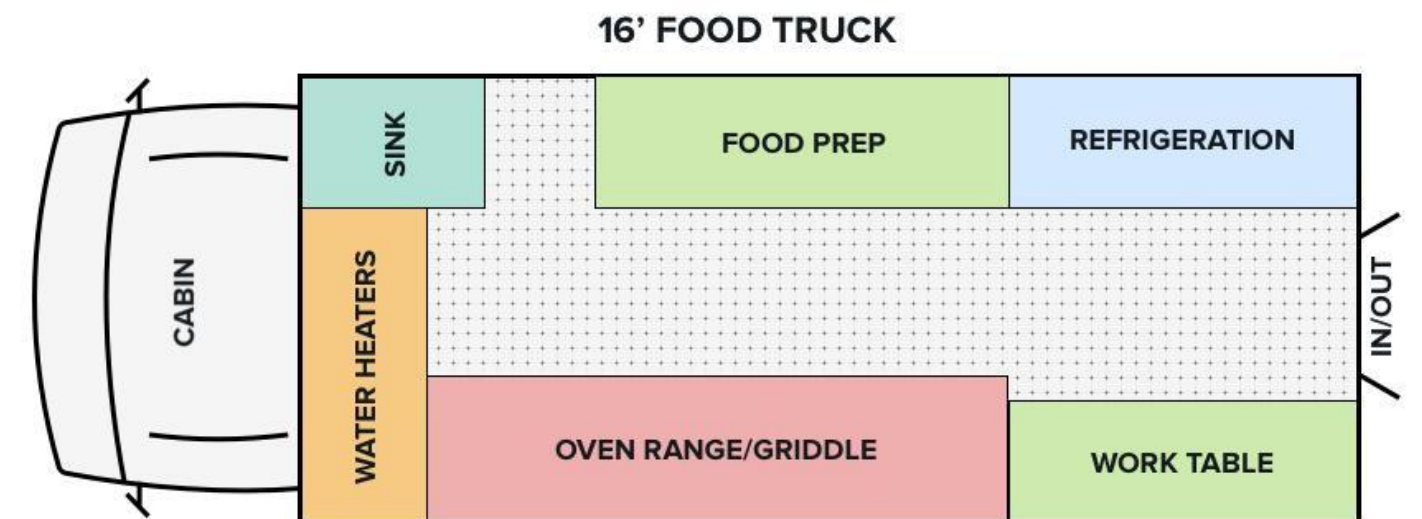
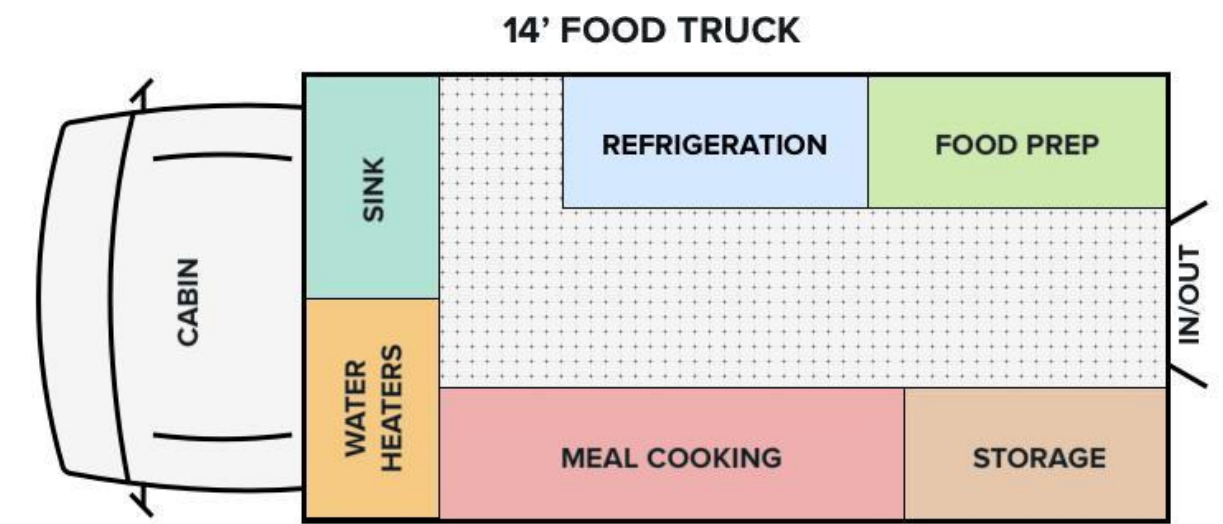
CALIFORNIA LEGAL MAXIMUMS (DMV LIMITS)

Max Width: 8.5 feet (102 inches)

Max Height: 14 feet

Max Length: 40 feet

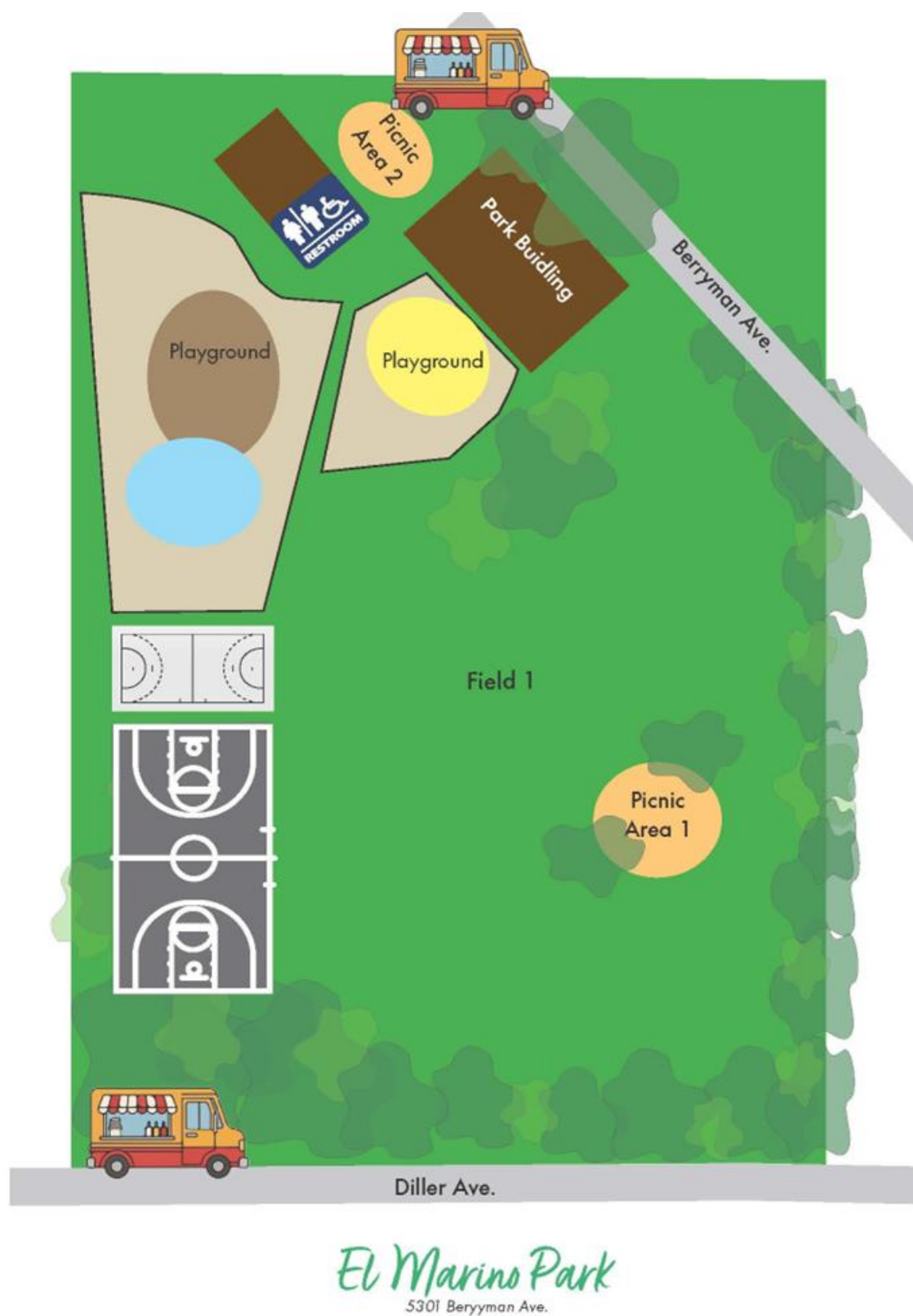
While California allows much larger commercial vehicles, most food trucks in Los Angeles operate between 14 and 24 feet, which makes them suitable for park environments when proper spacing is planned.



PROPOSED PARKS LOCATIONS



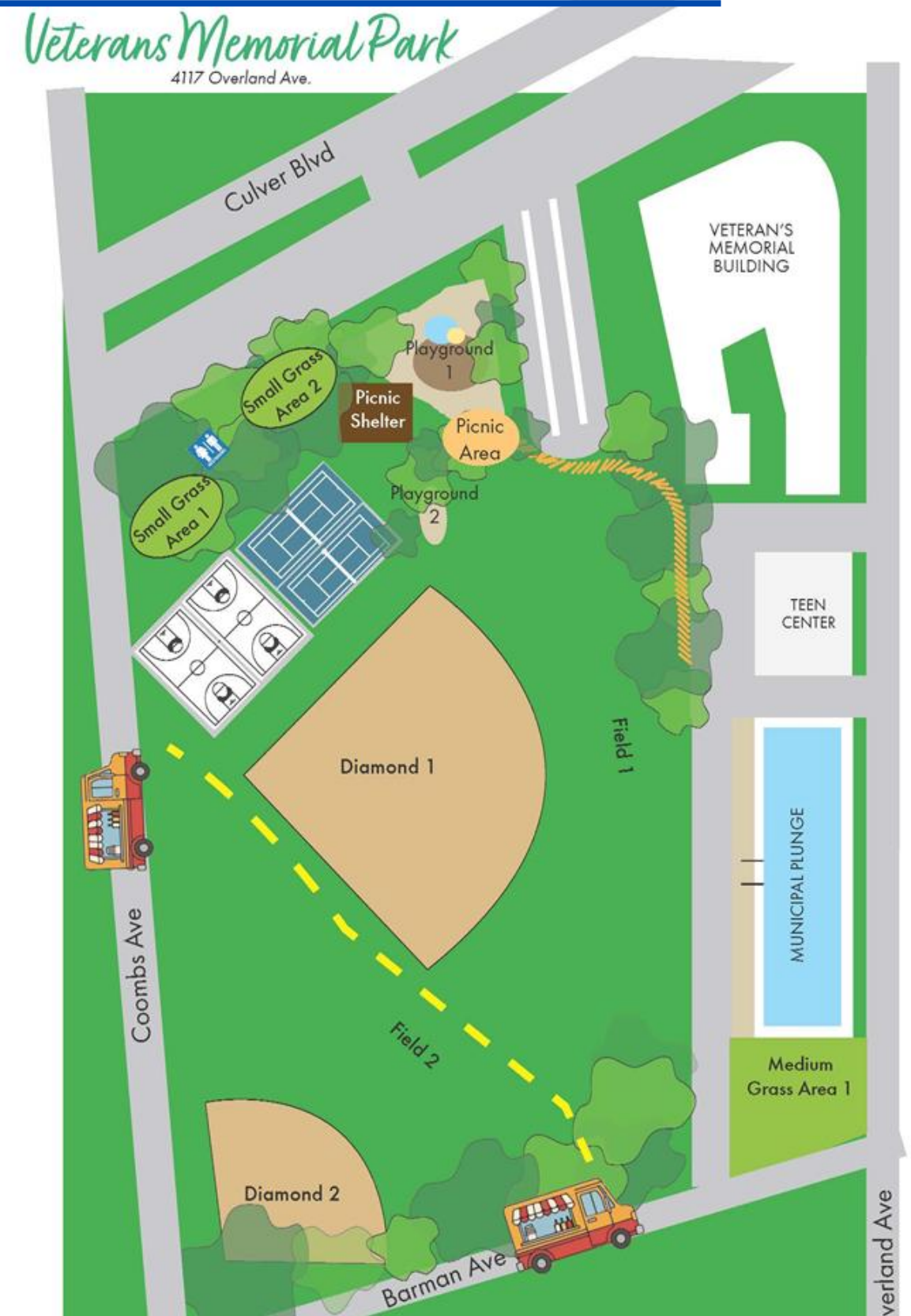
PROPOSED PARKS LOCATIONS



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TERMS AND CONDITIONS



Permit Requirements

- Valid for 1 year (non-transferable)
- Must be renewed annually
- Permit approval copy must be available on-site



Regulatory Compliance

- Culver City Municipal Code
- LA County Public Health
- California Retail Food Code
- Fire safety compliance required
- State & federal laws



Location & Operations

Must not:

- Block entrances, pathways, or ADA routes
- Interfere with permitted park activities
- Operate in restricted or sensitive areas

TERMS AND CONDITIONS



Location & Operations

- Minimum 4-ft pedestrian clearance
- ADA accessibility at all times



Cleanliness & Waste

- Provide trash receptacles
- Remove all operational waste
- No grease or wastewater in drains
- Maintain clean vending area



Operational Restrictions

- Must operate as a self-contained unit
- No external power, plumbing, or sidewalk generators
- Must park legally
- No tables, chairs, or seating
- No alcohol sales
