Meeting Minutes

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER WYANT, SECONDED BY VICE CHAIR VONCANNON AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVE MINUTES FOR THE MEETINGS OF JANUARY 27, 2016 AND FEBRUARY 17, 2016.

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Public Hearings

Item PH-1

Administrative Site Plan Review, P2015-0122-ASPR, Tentative Parcel Map, P2015-0122-TPM, and an exception to certain subdivision requirements for the development of a 3-Unit Townhome Style Subdivision at 4241 Duquesne Avenue in The Medium Density Multiple-Family Residential (RMD) Zone

Jose Mendivil, Associate Planner, provided a summary of the material of record.

Commissioner Sayles disclosed that she was involved in a property at 4139-41 Duquesne but can participate in the hearing since the property is more than 500 feet away.

Discussion ensued between staff and Commissioners regarding the status of potential improvements on Duquesne; the dedication for future widening of Duquesne; circulation elements; the need for the full dedication from all the properties; signalization at Braddock and Farragut; community meetings with the neighborhood; clarification that there are no current plans for widening Duquesne; notification to Commissioners when community meetings take place; and clarification regarding typographical errors.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER WYANT, SECONDED BY VICE CHAIR VONCANNON AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION OPEN THE PUBLIC HEARING.

Chair Lachoff invited public comment.

The following member of the audience addressed the Commission:

Rick Abramson, Project Architect, provided an overview of the project.

Discussion ensued between Mr. Abramson and Commissioners regarding size of units; programming; changing lifestyles; flex spaces; photovoltaics; insulation; passive cooling; thermal projections; grasscrete; drainage; planting strips; and options.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER SAYLES, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER OGOSTA AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION CLOSE THE PUBLIC HEARING.

Discussion ensued between the staff and Commissioners regarding the respectful nature of the project toward the neighbors and the neighborhood; the material palette; passive air circulation; development of the neighborhood guidelines; noise impacts; Village Tree Preschool; overlook of the yard; appreciation for the thoughtful planning and for not building to the maximum density; the age of current housing stock in the City; and scale and massing.

MOVED BY COMMISSIONER WYANT, SECONDED BY COMMISSIONER OGOSTA AND UNANIMOUSLY CARRIED, THAT THE PLANNING COMMISSION APPROVE ADMINISTRATIVE SITE PLAN REVIEW, P2015-0122-ASPR, TENTATIVE PARCEL MAP, P2015-0122-TPM, AND AN EXCEPTION TO CERTAIN SUBDIVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF A 3-UNIT TOWNHOME STYLE DIVISION LOCATED AT 4241 DUQUESNE AVENUE IN THE MEDIUM DENSITY MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (RMD) WITH A CORRECTION TO CONDITION #30 TO ADD "THE APPLICANT SHALL...".

Discussion ensued between staff and Commissioners regarding the RFP for consultants; small subdivisions on a normal multi-family lot; expanding the concept to other parts of the City; small lot developments in the City; affordable housing; hitting affordable targets; attainable rather than affordable; and the General Plan update.

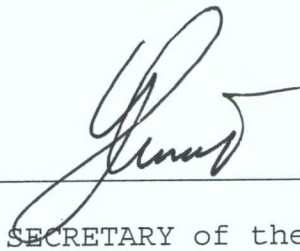
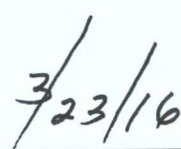
Commissioner Sayles announced that the memorial for Linda Smith Frost was planned for March 13, 2016.

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Adjournment

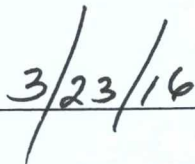
