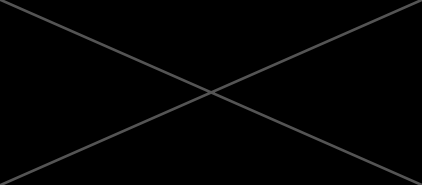

I support the conceptual plans for the “Better Overland” and “Safer Fox Hills” project, and I hope you will too.

Our Bicycle and Pedestrian Action Plan (adopted 2020) recommends 22.85 miles of new bikeways, and the proposed projects can move us significantly toward that goal.
