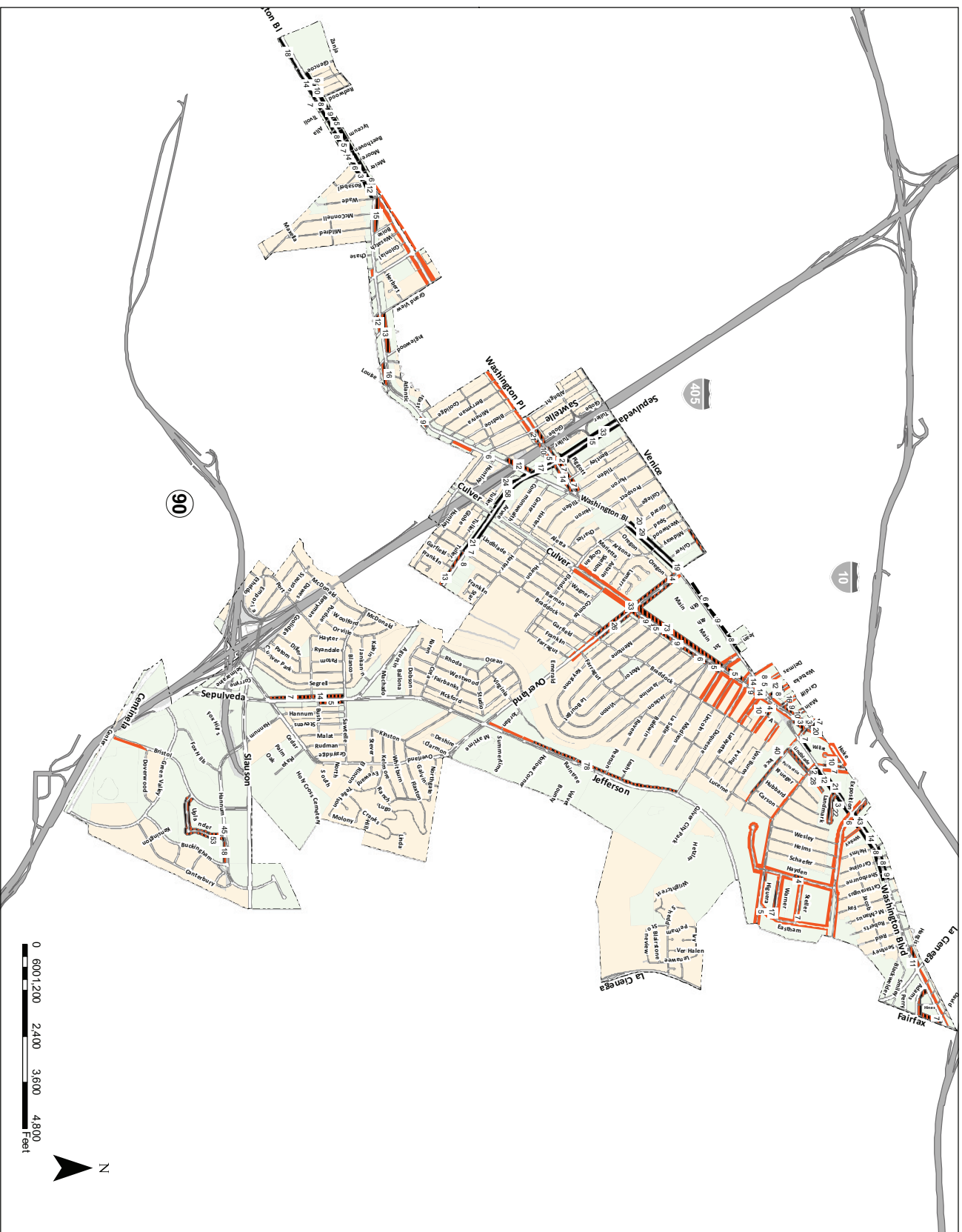
Meters in Front of Residences



Examples of Locations with a Need for Meters

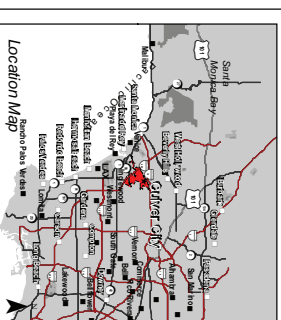

§ 7.03.415 STOPPING, STANDING AND PARKING OF BUSES AND TAXICABS REGULATED.

A. The operator of a bus shall not stand or park such vehicle upon any street at any place other than a bus stand so designated as provided herein.

B. The operator of a bus shall not stop such vehicle upon any street at any place for the purpose of loading or unloading passengers or their baggage other than at a bus stop, bus stand, or passenger loading zone so designated as provided herein, except in case of an emergency.

C. The operator of a taxicab shall not stand or park such vehicle upon any street at any place other than in a taxicab stand so designated as provided herein. This provision shall not prevent the operator of a taxicab from temporarily stopping in accordance with other stopping or parking regulations at any place for the purpose of and while actually engaged in the expeditious loading or unloading of passengers.

§ 7.03.420 RESTRICTED USE OF BUS AND TAXICAB STANDS.

No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle other than a bus in a bus stop, or other than a taxicab in a taxicab stand when any such stop or stand has been officially designated and appropriately signed, except that the driver of a passenger vehicle may temporarily stop therein for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading passengers when such stopping does not interfere with any bus, or taxicab waiting to enter or about to enter such zone.

PARKING METERS

§ 7.03.500 PARKING METER ZONES.

The streets, portions of streets or areas hereinafter described within the City, are hereby defined and established as parking meter zones within which parking of vehicles shall be controlled and regulated with the aid of parking meters:

A. Those portions of the following streets within the City of Culver City:

1. Cardiff Avenue;
2. Delmas Terrace;
3. Eastham Drive;

4. Hayden Avenue;
5. Hayden Place;
6. Higuera Avenue;
7. Hoke Avenue;
8. Hughes Avenue;
9. Landmark Street;
10. Main Street;
11. National Boulevard;
12. Robertson Boulevard;
13. Steller Drive;
14. Uplander Way;
15. Warner Drive;
16. Washington Place;
17. Watseka Avenue; and
18. Willat Avenue.

B. Those portions of the following streets between Washington Boulevard and Braddock Drive:

1. Duquesne Avenue;
2. Irving Place;
3. Madison Avenue; and
4. Van Buren Street.

C. Those portions of the following streets between Culver Boulevard and Braddock Drive:

1. LaFayette Place; and
2. Lincoln Avenue.

D. Those portions of southbound Sepulveda Boulevard between:

1. Braddock Drive and Greenlawn Avenues; and

2. Sawtelle Boulevard and Jefferson Boulevard/Playa Street.
- E. That portion of northbound Sepulveda Boulevard between Bush Way and Sawtelle Boulevard.
- F. Those portions of westbound Washington Boulevard between:
 1. La Cienega Boulevard and Hargis Street;
 2. Sepulveda Boulevard and Globe Avenue;
 3. Inglewood and Grandview Boulevards; and
 4. Boise Avenue and Wade Street.
- G. Those portions of eastbound Washington Boulevard between:
 1. Kenyon Avenue and Centinela Avenue;
 2. Grandview Boulevard and Lindblade Drive;
 3. Inglewood Boulevard and Louise Avenue;
 4. McLaughlin Avenue and Coolidge Avenue;
 5. Purdue Avenue and Corinth Avenue; and
 6. Sawtelle Boulevard and Huntley Avenue.
- H. Adams Boulevard (northbound) between Fairfax Avenue and Washington Boulevard.
- I. Bristol Parkway (northbound) between Centinela Avenue and Doverwood Drive.
- J. Culver Boulevard between Elenda Street and Venice Boulevard.
- K. Fairfax Avenue (southbound) between Washington and Adams Boulevards.
- L. Hannum Avenue between Uplander Way and Buckingham Parkway.
- M. Ince Boulevard between Venice Boulevard and Lucerne Avenue.
- N. The north side of Jefferson Boulevard between Duquesne Avenue and Overland Avenue.
- O. Lindblade Street between Ince Boulevard and its easterly terminus.
- P. Overland Avenue between Washington Boulevard and Farragut Drive.
- Q. Venice Boulevard between Midway Avenue and Overland Avenue.
- R. Wesley Street between Washington Boulevard and National Boulevard.

S. All municipal and Redevelopment Agency parking lots, used by the general public, are hereby established as a parking meter zone unless monthly charges are collected.

§ 7.03.505 MANNER OF INSTALLATION.

A. The Public Works Director shall cause parking meters to be installed and maintained in all parking meter zones.

B. Parking meters shall be installed in the sidewalk or parkway area immediately adjacent to each parking space. Each meter shall be placed in such manner as to show or display by a sign or signal that the parking space adjacent thereto is or is not legally in use.

C. Each parking meter shall be set to display, after the operational procedure has been completed, a sign or signal indicating legal parking. Each parking meter shall indicate the limit of parking time in the parking space adjacent to the parking meter, and shall continue to operate from the time of the completion of the operational procedure until the expiration of the time fixed as the parking limit or a portion thereof for the part of the street upon which said meter is placed. Each said meter shall also be so arranged that upon the expiration of said legal parking time it will indicate by a mechanical operation and by proper signal that the lawful parking period has expired.

§ 7.03.510 TIME OF OPERATION.

The provisions of this Subchapter relating to the operation of parking meters shall be effective between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on every day except holidays or as otherwise indicated by appropriate signs.

§ 7.03.515 OPERATIONAL PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED.

Immediately after occupancy of a parking meter space, the operator of a vehicle shall deposit a coin of the United States in said parking meter and if necessary turn a crank, knob, or handle in accordance with the instructions posted on the face of the parking meter.

§ 7.03.520 PARKING METER FEES.

The City Council shall from time to time establish by resolution the parking meter fees for the various parking meter zones within the City. Said resolution shall designate the zone, or section thereof,

the amount of the fee and time period, and the time of operation for the meters therein.

§ 7.03.525 UNLAWFUL TO PARK AFTER METER TIME HAS EXPIRED.

No operator of any vehicle shall permit said vehicle to remain parked in any parking space during any time that the meter is showing a signal indicating that such space is illegally in use other than such time necessary for the operator to comply with § 7.03.515.

§ 7.03.530 IMPROPER USE OF METER.

A. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited in any parking meter any defaced or bent coin, or any slug, device, foreign matter, metallic substitute for a coin of the United States; or deface, injure, tamper with, open or willfully break, destroy or impair the usefulness of any parking meter.

B. Violation of this provision shall constitute a misdemeanor, subject to a fine not to exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), six months in jail, or both.

§ 7.03.535 METERS AND STANDARDS NOT TO BE USED FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

No person shall attach anything to or allow a bicycle, newsrack or any other article or thing to lean against a parking meter or a parking meter standard.

§ 7.03.540 RULE OF EVIDENCE.

The parking or standing of any motor vehicle in a parking space, at which space the parking meter displays the sign or signal indicating illegal parking, shall constitute a prima facie presumption that the vehicle has been parked or allowed to stand in such space for a period longer than permitted by this Chapter.

§ 7.03.545 APPLICATION OF OTHER PROVISIONS.

No Section of this Subchapter shall be construed as permitting any parking in violation of any other provision of this Code.

§ 7.03.550 USE OF MONEY DEPOSITED IN PARKING METER.

All moneys deposited in parking meters in this City shall be collected by duly authorized agents of the City Treasurer and shall be placed in a Parking Meter Fund, which fund shall be devoted exclusively to the following purposes:

- A. For the purchasing, leasing, otherwise acquiring, improving and maintaining of off-street parking facilities in this City.
- B. To be pledged as security for the payment of and interest on, off-street parking revenue bonds issued by this City, or any parking district organized within this City.
- C. For traffic safety and enforcement and for such other purposes related to off-street parking as shall be determined from time to time by the City Council.

§ 7.03.555 UNINTENTIONAL VIOLATION.

- A. Any person unintentionally violating any provision of this Subchapter, by reason of a mechanical failure of a parking meter not caused by such person, may be acquitted of such violation upon establishing such facts by a preponderance of the evidence.
- B. Exception: A violation of § 7.03.530 is a strict liability offense. Even unintentional deposit of a coin substitute and/or damage to a parking meter under the provisions of § 7.03.530 shall subject the offender to the penalty established.

***PROHIBITED AND LIMITED PARKING OF OVERSIZED, NON-MOTORIZED
AND COMMERCIAL VEHICLES***

§ 7.03.600 DEFINITIONS.

For the purposes of this Subchapter, the following definitions shall apply unless the context clearly indicates or requires a different meaning. Any term that is not defined herein shall have the meaning as set forth in the California Vehicle Code.

CHIEF OF POLICE. The Chief of Police of the City of Culver City or his or her designee.

COMMERCIAL VEHICLE. Any vehicle having more than two axles, or any single ***COMMERCIAL VEHICLE*** or combination of said vehicles that exceed twenty (20) feet in length, or any single ***COMMERCIAL VEHICLE*** or combination of said vehicles eighty-four (84) inches or more

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code §22508 gives cities the authority to establish, by ordinance, parking meter zones; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish the specific parking meter locations within the established parking meter zone by resolution; and

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

1 **§ 7.03.500 PURPOSE.**

2 The purpose of this Subchapter is to establish parking meter zones,
3 parking meter fees and regulations applicable to parking meters.

4 **§ 7.03.505 PARKING METER ZONES.**

5 All public streets within the City are hereby established as parking
6 meter zones within which the City may install parking meters for the purpose
7 of controlling and regulating the parking of vehicles. The specific locations for
8 the installation of parking meters within the City's parking meter zones shall
9 be established by resolution of the City Council.

10 **§ 7.03.510 MANNER OF INSTALLATION.**

11 A. The Public Works Director/City Engineer shall cause parking
12 meters to be installed and maintained in all parking meter locations
13 established pursuant to § 7.03.505.

14 B. Except for multi-space meters, parking meters shall be installed
15 in the sidewalk or parkway area immediately adjacent to each parking space
16 and shall be placed in such manner as to conspicuously show or display by a
17 sign or signal that the parking space adjacent thereto is or is not legally in
18 use.

19 C. Multi-space parking meters shall be installed at various nearby
20 locations to provide metering for more than one parking space at a time.
21 Parking spaces that are controlled by multi-space parking meters shall be
22 clearly designated by a posted sign, pavement marking, or other clearly
23 visible means. A "multi-space parking meter" is a pay station for multiple
24 parking spaces placed at various locations along streets for the payment and
25 control of parking thereon. The term "parking meter," as hereinafter used in
26 this Subchapter, shall include "multi-space parking meter."

1 **§ 7.03.515 OPERATIONAL PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED.**

2 Except as otherwise provided in this Subchapter, immediately after
3 occupancy of a metered parking space, the vehicle operator shall pay the
4 required fee for use of the metered parking space in accordance with the
5 directions prescribed by the parking meter adjacent to or assigned to the
6 metered parking space, unless the parking meter indicates an unexpired
7 portion remains of the period of time for which payment previously had been
8 deposited.

9
10 **§ 7.03.520 PARKING METER FEES AND TIME OF OPERATION.**

11 The City Council shall establish by resolution the parking meter fees
12 for the various parking meter locations established within the City's parking
13 meter zones. Said resolution shall specify the parking meter location, the
14 amount of the parking meter fee for that location, the time period covered by
15 the fee and the time of operation for the meters therein.

16
17 **SECTION 2.** Section 7.03.535 of the Culver City Municipal Code is hereby
18 amended as follows (deletions indicated by ~~strikethrough~~ and additions indicated by
19 underline):

20 **§ 7.03.535 METERS AND STANDARDS NOT TO BE USED FOR**
21 **CERTAIN PURPOSES.**

22 No person shall attach anything to or allow a bicycle, newsrack or any
23 other article or thing to lean against a parking meter or a parking meter
24 standard unless said meter or meter standard has been altered by the City or
25 approved designee to include a bicycle rack and has been designated as
26 such by the Public Works Director/City Engineer.

1 **SECTION 3.** Section 7.03.550 of the Culver City Municipal Code is hereby
2 amended as follows (deletions indicated by ~~strike through~~ and additions indicated by
3 underline):

4 **§ 7.03.550 USE OF MONEY DEPOSITED IN PARKING METER.**

5 All moneys deposited in parking meters in the City shall be collected
6 by duly authorized agents of the City Treasurer and shall be placed in a
7 Parking Meter Fund, which fund shall be devoted exclusively to the following
8 purposes:

9 A. ~~For the p~~Purchasing, leasing, otherwise acquiring, improving
10 and maintaining of on-street parking meters and off-street parking facilities in
11 the City.

12 B. ~~To be pledged as s~~Security for the payment of and interest on,
13 off-street parking revenue bonds issued by the City, or any parking district
14 organized within the City.

15 C. Personnel, software, hardware, tools and equipment to be used
16 to collect current data and make other improvements to further ~~For~~ traffic
17 safety, efficiency, and enforcement ~~and for such other purposes related to~~
18 ~~off-street parking as shall be determined from time to time by the City~~
19 ~~Council.~~

20 D. Such other purposes related to on-street or off-street parking as
21 shall be determined from time to time by the City Council.

22 **SECTION 4.** Pursuant to Section 619 of the City Charter, this Ordinance
23 shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption. Pursuant to Sections 616
24 and 621 of the City Charter, prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the adoption,
25 the City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance, or a summary thereof, to be published in the
26 Culver City News and shall post this Ordinance or a summary thereof in at least three
27 places within the City.
28

SECTION 5. The City Council hereby declares that, if any provision, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this ordinance is rendered or declared invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council would have independently adopted the remaining provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this ordinance and as such they shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 2. Exemptions. Notwithstanding the foregoing locations listed in Section 1, parking meters shall not be installed at the following locations:

1. Locations that do not require parking turnover including: 1) religious site adjacencies, 2) school adjacencies, 3) state and federal government building adjacencies, and 4) business adjacencies where the parking demand stems primarily from employees rather than patrons/residents or where the business has sufficient off-street

1 parking and there is little demand for on-street parking (unless the installation of parking
2 meters is requested by the property owner); and,

3 2. Residential adjacencies if requested by petition.
