

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA,
AMENDING SECTION 3.05.010 OF CHAPTER 3.05
“PERSONNEL POLICIES” OF THE CULVER CITY MUNICIPAL
CODE, TO BE CONSISTENT WITH CHANGES TO RULE 3
“CLASSIFICATION,” OF THE CIVIL SERVICE RULES.

The City Council of the City of Culver City, California, **DOES HEREBY**
ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1: Section 3.05.010 of the Culver City Municipal Code is hereby
amended as follows (~~strikethrough~~ denotes deletion, underline denotes addition):

§ 3.05.010 CIVIL SERVICE RULES.

In addition to such other rules as the Civil Service Commission may
determine are necessary and proper to carry out the intent and purpose of the
personnel program, the following ~~rules~~ duties, tasks and principles shall
~~govern~~ be addressed in the Civil Service Rules:

- A. Preparation, installation, revision and maintenance of a position
classification plan covering all positions in the Classified
Service, including employment standards and qualifications for
each class.
- B. Preparation, revision, and administration of a plan of
compensation directly correlated with the position classification
plan, providing a rate or range of pay for each class.
- C. Public announcement of all tests and the acceptance of
applications for employment.
- D. Preparation and conduct of tests and the establishment and use
of resulting eligible lists containing names of persons eligible for
appointment.
- E. Certification and appointment of persons from eligible lists, and
making of temporary appointments.
- F. Evaluation of employees during the probationary period.
- G. Transfer, promotion, demotion and reinstatement of employees
in the Classified Service.
- H. Separation of employees from municipal service through layoff,
suspension and dismissal.
- I. Standardization of hours of work, attendance and leave
regulations, working conditions and the development of
employee morale, welfare, education and training.
- J. Suitable provision for orderly and equitable presentations to the
Council by employees relating to general conditions of
employment.

1 K. Content, maintenance and use of personnel records and forms.

2 **SECTION 2:** Section 3.05.020 of the Culver City Municipal Code is hereby
3 amended as follows (~~strikethrough~~ denotes deletion, underline denotes addition):

4 **§ 3.05.020 PERSONNEL OFFICER; DUTIES.**

- 5 A. *Designation of officer.* The Personnel Officer shall be the City
6 Manager, or such person as appointed by the City Manager.
7 Duties may be combined with those of any other office or
8 position, provided the appointee shall have had training or
9 experience in personnel administration.
- 10 B. *Duties.*
- 11 1. Attend all meetings of the Civil Service Commission and
12 serve as liaison officer between the City Manager and the Civil
13 Service Commission.
 - 14 2. Administer all of the provisions of the Rules not
15 specifically reserved to the City Council, the Civil Service
16 Commission, or the City Manager.
 - 17 3. Assist the Civil Service Commission in the preparation,
18 study and analysis of Rules and revisions and amendments
19 thereto, for submission to the City Council after approval by City
20 Attorney as to legality of such action.
 - 21 4. Assist the Civil Service Commission in the periodic study,
and analysis and/or preparation of classification and pay plans,
including class specifications and revisions of said plans
covering all classifications in the Classified Service; the plans,
and any revisions thereto, become effective upon approval of
City Council of salaries paid by other public and private
agencies, at the discretion of the City Council, as set forth in
Section 3.03.100 of this Code.
 - 22 5. Encourage the improvement of municipal service by
23 studying needs and recommending programs for education and
24 training to the City Manager; such programs becoming effective
25 upon approval by the Civil Service Commission and the City
26 Council.

27 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** Pursuant to Section 619 of the City
28 Charter, this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption.

SECTION 4. SEVERABILITY. The City Council hereby declares that, if
any provision, section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this
Ordinance is rendered or declared invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court

1 of competent jurisdiction or by reason of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council
2 would have independently adopted the remaining provisions, sections, subsections,
3 paragraphs, sentences, phrases or words of this Ordinance and as such they shall
4 remain in full force and effect.

5 **SECTION 5. PUBLICATION.** Pursuant to Sections 616 and 621 of the City
6 Charter, prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the adoption, the City Clerk shall
7 cause this Ordinance, or a summary thereof, to be published in the Culver City News
8 and shall post this Ordinance or a summary thereof in at least three places within the
9 City.
