3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
4 OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING
5 PARKING METER FEES, THE TIME PERIOD
6 COVERED BY SUCH FEES, THE TIME OF
7 OPERATION FOR THE PARKING METER LOCATIONS,
8 AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2013-R063.

9 WHEREAS, pursuant to Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC") Section
10 7.03.500, all public streets within the City were established as parking meter zones;
11 and, by separate resolution, the City Council established the specific locations for the
12 installation of parking meters within such parking meter zones; and

13 WHEREAS, pursuant to CCMC Section 7.03.520, the City Council shall
14 establish by resolution the parking meter fees for the various parking meter locations
15 within the City. Said resolution shall specify the parking meter location, the amount of
16 the parking meter fee for that location, the time period covered by the fee and the time
17 of operation for the meters therein; and

18 WHEREAS, it is the City Council's intent to efficiently manage the on-
19 street parking supply by: (1) establishing parking meter fees for on-street parking in the
20 Culver City Downtown areas that are higher than the fees for the City's parking
21 structures in order to facilitate the City's goal of obtaining an 85% parking meter
22 occupancy rate for peak periods; (2) establishing reduced parking meter fees for
23 parking meters that cater to employees; and (3) establishing longer parking meter
24 operating hours at locations with a higher parking demand in the evening hours.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City DOES
26 HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:
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1. The parking meter fee for all parking meters located in the Culver City Downtown areas, as illustrated on Exhibit "A" attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference, shall be One Dollar and Fifty Cents (\$1.50) per hour. The time of operation for such meters shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. every day, except Sundays and holidays, as indicated by posted signs or on meter face.
2. The parking meter fee for all parking meters with time limits shorter than ten (10) hours in duration, which are located on Jefferson Boulevard, between 200 feet west of Hetzler Road and the City boundary approximately 350 feet east of Hetzler Road, as illustrated on Exhibit "B" attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference, shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) per hour. The time of operation for such meters shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., every day except holidays as indicated by posted signs or on meter face.
3. Except for the parking meter locations identified in Section 1 of this Resolution, the parking meter fee for all parking meter locations within the City, which have time limits of ten (10) hours or longer in duration, shall be Twenty-Five Cents (\$0.25) per hour. If purchasing time by credit card at such meters, a minimum of two hours shall be purchased. The time of operation for such meters shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., every day except Sundays and holidays, as indicated by posted signs or on meter face.

- 1 4. Except for parking meter locations identified in Section 1 of this
2 Resolution, the parking meter fee for all parking meter locations
3 within the City which have time limits of fifteen (15) minutes in
4 duration, shall be Seventy Five Cents (\$0.75) per fifteen (15)
5 minutes. If purchasing time by credit card at such meters, a
6 minimum of ten minutes shall be purchased. The time of operation
7 for such meters shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., every day
8 except Sundays and holidays, as indicated by posted signs or on
9 meter face.
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11 5. Except for parking meter locations identified in Sections 1, 2, 3 and
12 4 of this Resolution, the parking meter fee for all parking meter
13 locations within the City shall be One Dollar (\$1.00) per hour. The
14 time of operation for such meters shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00
15 p.m., every day except Sundays and holidays, as indicated by
16 posted signs or on meter face.
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18 6. The parking meter fees, the time period covered by the fees and
19 the time of operation for the parking meter locations established
20 herein shall become effective upon adoption of this Resolution.
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2 7. Resolution No. 2013-R063 is hereby rescinded.

Dear Gabe:

The Board of Directors of the Culver City Downtown Business Association would like to request a change to seven of the currently metered parking spaces in downtown, from regular metered parking to 15 minute parking spaces. These spaces would be for customers picking up to-go orders etc., alleviating the need to find street or garage parking, and thereby improving the flow of traffic as well as our parking inventory. We understand that there will be a need to change the parking cost to 75¢ per 15 minutes to cover parking and credit card costs, and to assure the spaces are used as intended.

The Parking Project Team has determined which spaces would best serve our needs:

- CC 45 & CC 46 (on Culver near Starbucks)
- CO 34 & CO 33 (on Cardiff near Ugo)
- DA 01 (on Irving close to Washington)
- Main St- 18 & 29 – (in front of BottleRock & in front of Public School)
