1 RESOLUTION NO. 2014-R_____

2 **A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF**
3 **CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING THE**
4 **ESTABLISHED RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE USE**
5 **OF PUBLIC SKATEBOARD PARKS WITHIN THE CITY AND**
6 **RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. 2007-R049**

7 **WHEREAS**, Culver City Municipal Code Section 9.10.300.B provides that the
8 City Council may, by resolution, establish rules and regulations regarding the use of public
9 skateboard parks within the City; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to establish
11 such rules and regulations in order to protect the public's health, safety and welfare; and

12 **WHEREAS**, on August 13, 2007, the City Council adopted Resolution No.
13 2007-R049 establishing such rules and regulations, which have been in place for
14 approximately seven years without updates or modifications (the "Rules and Regulations");
15 and
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17 **WHEREAS**, Parks, Recreation and Community Services ("PRCS") staff has
18 proposed revisions to the Rules and Regulations based on the current use of the Skate Park
19 and the observed behavior patterns of regular users; and

20 **WHEREAS**, at its meeting of June 17, 2014, the PRCS Commission approved
21 the proposed revisions to the Rules and Regulations and recommended to the City Council
22 that such revisions be adopted.

24 **NOW, THEREFORE**, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
25 **DOES HEREBY RESOLVE** as follows:
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1 1. The following rules and regulations regarding the use of public
2 skateboard parks within the City are hereby amended to read as follows:

- 3 a) All skaters must wear a helmet, elbow pads and knee pads at all
4 times while skating.
- 5 b) Public entry into the skate park is prohibited at all times that the skate
6 park gates are locked.
- 7 c) Skating is prohibited at all times that it is raining or when the skating
8 area is wet or contains a large amount of debris.
- 9 d) The skate park is for skating use only, including skateboarding,
10 rollerskating, in-line skating, rollerblading and non-motorized scooters
11 only. Bicycling, the use of motorized devices of any type and all
12 other uses are prohibited.
- 13 e) Only skaters are permitted within the skating area.
- 14 f) No food, drink, glass or breakable objects are allowed within the
15 skating area.
- 16 g) No one is allowed to clean the skating area using cleaning solvents
17 or solutions except City staff or other City-authorized personnel.
- 18 h) No drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, weapons or pets are allowed
19 within the skate park.
- 20 i) No portion of the skate park may be modified, altered or added to in
21 any manner without written permission of the City's Parks, Recreation
22 and Community Services Director.
- 23 j) Skating is only permitted within the skate park and is prohibited in all
24 other areas of Culver City Park, including its adjacent sidewalks,
25 streets and parking lots.
- 26 k) Competitive, demonstration and rental events are prohibited, unless
27 written permission is obtained from the Parks, Recreation and
28 Community Services Director.
- l) All parties are responsible for removing their personal property from
the premises upon leaving the skate park.

1 2. For purposes of this Resolution and the rules and regulations set forth
2 herein, the term "skating" includes skateboarding, rollerskating, in-line skating, rollerblading
3 and the use of non-motorized scooters only.

4 3. Any violation of the rules and regulations established by this Resolution
5 are subject to the penalties set forth in Culver City Municipal Code Section 9.10.300.C:

6 4. Resolution No. 2007-R049 is hereby rescinded.

7 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.
