

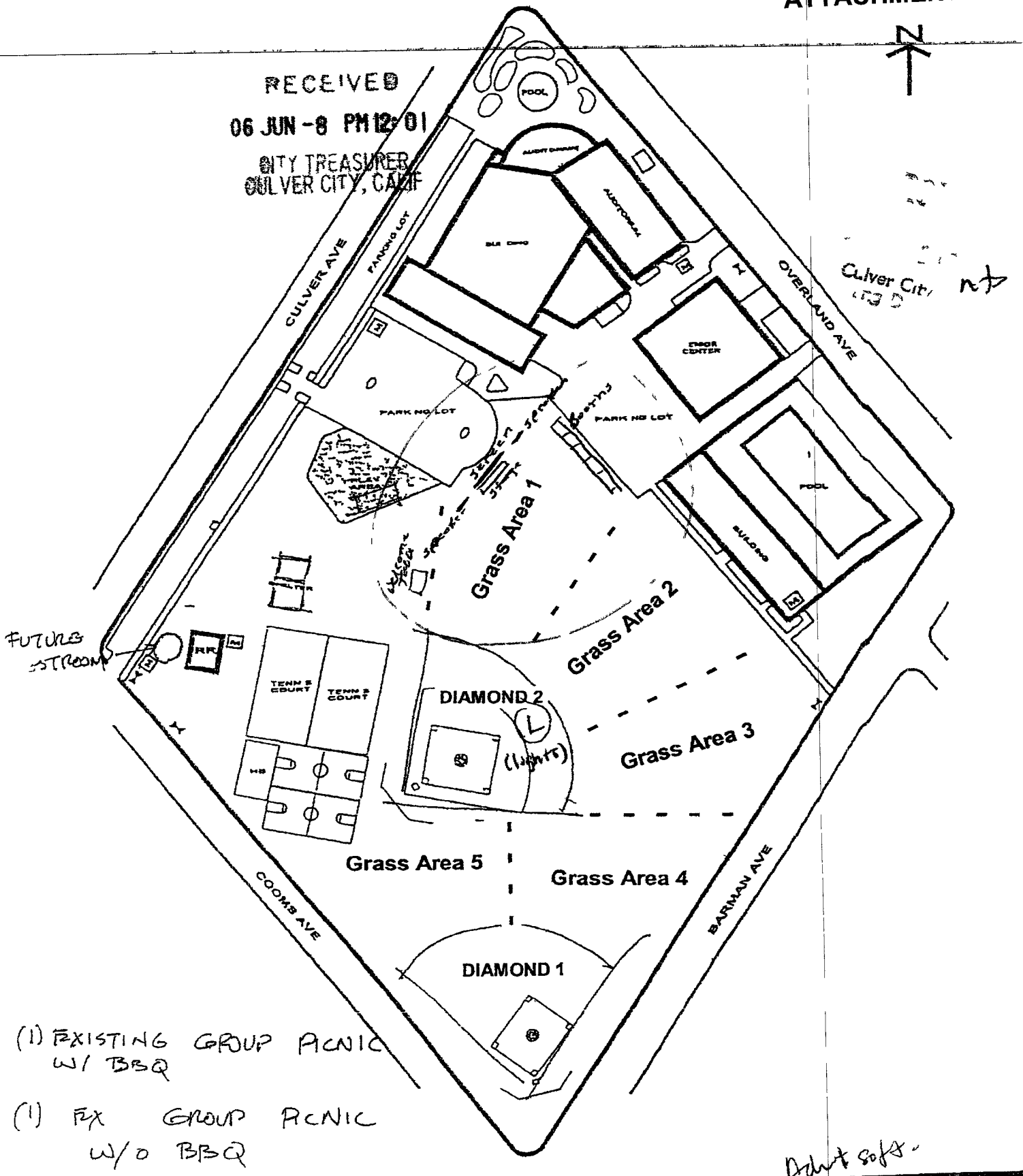

Lt D anjou stated that measurements taken at the event site indicated that the actual amplified sound is in excess of the minimum three hundred (300) foot distance to residences and that a sound permit therefore was not necessary for this event

Ms Robinson commented that the Parks & Recreation Department is working with the applicant, is happy with the way the event took place last year and is supportive of the event moving forward in approval of this application

Mr Cole indicated that the Committee on Permits and Licenses actions are predicated upon the execution of a license agreement that needs to go to the City Council This is being set up for the Council meeting being held on July 10 2006
