Two annual meetings generally occur in October or November; staff will contact members with dates.
Disability Advisory Committee	Rick Hudson <i>Delegate</i> Marianne Kim <i>Alternate</i>	Advises City staff and City Council on issues related to the disabled in the community. Typically meets the second Wednesday of even numbered months at 6:30 p.m. at the Veterans' Memorial Building.
