ORDINANCE NO. 2007-_____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING SECTION 9.10.300(B) OF THE CULVER CITY MUNICIPAL CODE TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY COUNCIL TO ESTABLISH, BY RESOLUTION, SKATEBOARD PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, Section 9.10.300 of the Culver City Municipal Code ("CCMC") provides that any person who rides or operates a skateboard, rollerskates, in-line skates or rollerblades in a publicly-owned or operated skateboard park in the City must wear a helmet, elbow pads and kneepads at all times; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Culver City has determined that additional rules and regulations relating to the use of such publicly-owned skateboard parks may be necessary in order to protect the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California, DOES HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 9.10.300(B) of the Culver City Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows (insertions indicated by underline; deletions indicated by strikethrough):

B. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Director is authorized to set forth any administrative guidelines or processes, and the City Council may establish by resolution ~~and/or necessary~~ rules and regulations, regarding the use of public skateboard parks within the City. Signage setting forth all rules and regulations established by this subsection, and the penalty for violation thereof, shall be posted at all public skateboard parks within the City. A violation of any rule or regulation established by this subsection shall be subject to the penalties as set forth in Section 9.10.300.C.

SECTION 2. Pursuant to Section 619 of the City Charter, this Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the date of its adoption. Pursuant to Sections 616

1 and 621 of the City Charter, prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days after the adoption,
2 the City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance, or a summary thereof, to be published in the
3 Culver City News and shall post this Ordinance or a summary thereof in at least three
4 places within the City.

5 **SECTION 3.** The City Council hereby declares that, if any provision, section,
6 subsection, paragraph, sentence, phrase or word of this ordinance is rendered or declared
7 invalid or unconstitutional by any final action in a court of competent jurisdiction or by
8 reason of any preemptive legislation, then the City Council would have independently
9 adopted the remaining provisions, sections, subsections, paragraphs, sentences, phrases
10 or words of this ordinance and as such they shall remain in full force and effect.

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-R_____

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CULVER CITY, CALIFORNIA, ESTABLISHING RULES AND
REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC SKATEBOARD
PARKS WITHIN THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Culver City Municipal Code Section 9.10.300(B) provides that the
City Council may, by resolution, establish rules and regulations regarding the use of public
skateboard parks within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is necessary to establish
such rules and regulations in order to protect the public's health, safety and welfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Culver City, California,
DOES HEREBY RESOLVE as follows:

1. The following rules and regulations regarding the use of public
skateboard parks within the City are hereby established:

- a. All skaters must wear a helmet, elbow pads and knee
pads at all times.
- b. Public entry into the skateboard park is prohibited at all
times the skateboard park gates are locked.
- c. Skating is prohibited at all times the skating area is wet or it
is raining.
- d. The skateboard park is for skating use only. All other uses
are prohibited.
- e. Only skaters are permitted within the skating area.

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f. No food, drink, glass or breakable objects are allowed within the skating area.

g. No drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, weapons or pets are allowed within the skateboard park.

h. No portion of the skateboard park may be modified, altered or added to in any manner without written permission of the City's Parks, Recreation and Community Services Director.

i. Skating is only permitted in the skateboard park and is prohibited in all of the surrounding areas.

j. Competitive, demonstration and rental events are prohibited, unless written permission is obtained from the City's Parks, Recreation and Community Services Director.

2. For purposes of this Resolution and the rules and regulations set forth herein, the term "skating" includes skateboarding, rollerskating, in-line skating and rollerblading.

3. Any violation of the rules and regulations established by this Resolution are subject to the penalties set forth in Culver City Municipal Code Section 9.10.300(C).

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4. This Resolution shall become effective concurrently with the effective date of Ordinance No. 2007-_____.
